The Unit is an independant research centre within the University, reporting through an Advisory Committee to the Vice-Chancellor. Its main financial support is from the National Health and Medical Research Council, but support is also received from the Commonwealth Department of Health and other outside sources, and the University makes a substantial contribution.

The Unit's research programme is directed towards health economics and statistics, with particular reference to the financing of health services, the economics of medical practice and the pharmaceutical industry. Full-time academic staff number four, with three support personnel. In addition, the Unit has supported several Visiting Fellows, whose work is related to our interests. The results from this work are reported in Research Reports, Research Monographs and Technical Papers, which are distributed by the Unit and the ANU Press. Publications in 1983 included a comparative analysis of Australian and Canadian health financing systems by a Visiting Fellow, Professor M.C. Brown of the University of Calgary; a report on labour costs in Victorian public hospitals by Dr. P.M. Tatchell; and the proceedings of the Fifth Australian Conference of Health Economists, a meeting organised annually by the Unit.
