The Unit has as its primary objective the provision of facilities for increasing the effectiveness of teaching and learning by the production and use of materials appropriate to the particular needs of faculties, research schools and central areas of the University.

I.R.U. provides cost effective centralised services, including audio production and tape duplication, television production and editing, service and maintenance of recommended equipment, language laboratory operation, original photography and processing, at a time when many areas of the University have had to drastically reduce the range of services possible within individual departments.

University needs are met at three levels: response service, where a specific request is made and the work is done by I.R.U. staff; 'Do-it-yourself' services where, after discussion and any necessary operational training, users are encouraged to use equipment and materials provided centrally; and production services, where a request or idea from the user is considered and, if appropriate, an I.R.U. team together with the user produces the relevant material.

Requests for I.R.U. services have increased substantially in 1980 with the largest growth being in videotaped materials produced for all areas of the University. Much of the material has also been sought by other educational institutions for use in their own teaching programmes.
