This year's student charity appeals met with more success than in previous years. A financially successful Bush Week raised over \$1000 to aid the Childrens' Medical Research Foundation, and a student-sponsored Biafra Hunger Appeal succeeded in raising \$9000 to send a medical team and provisions to Biafra.
