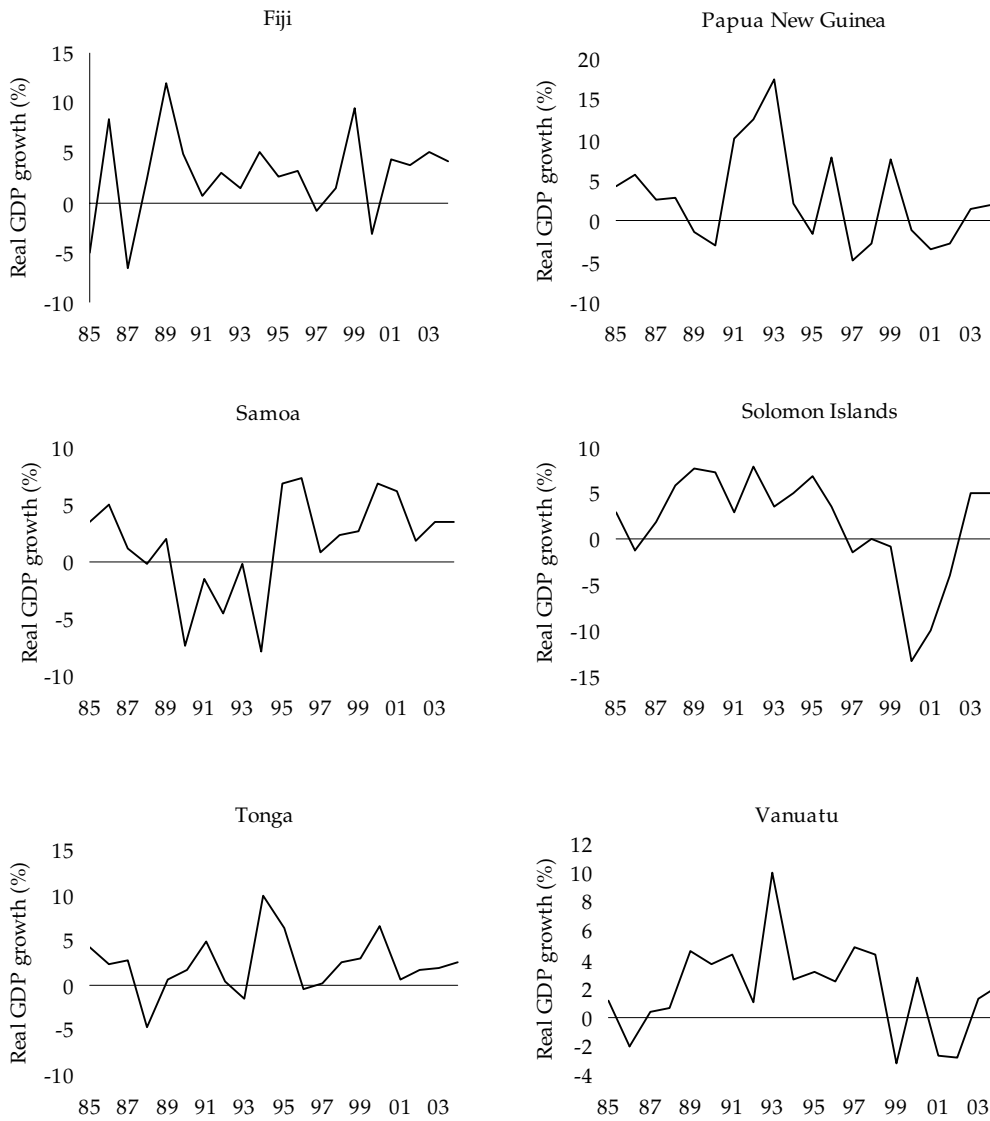

Figure 1 Real GDP growth rates, 1985–2004

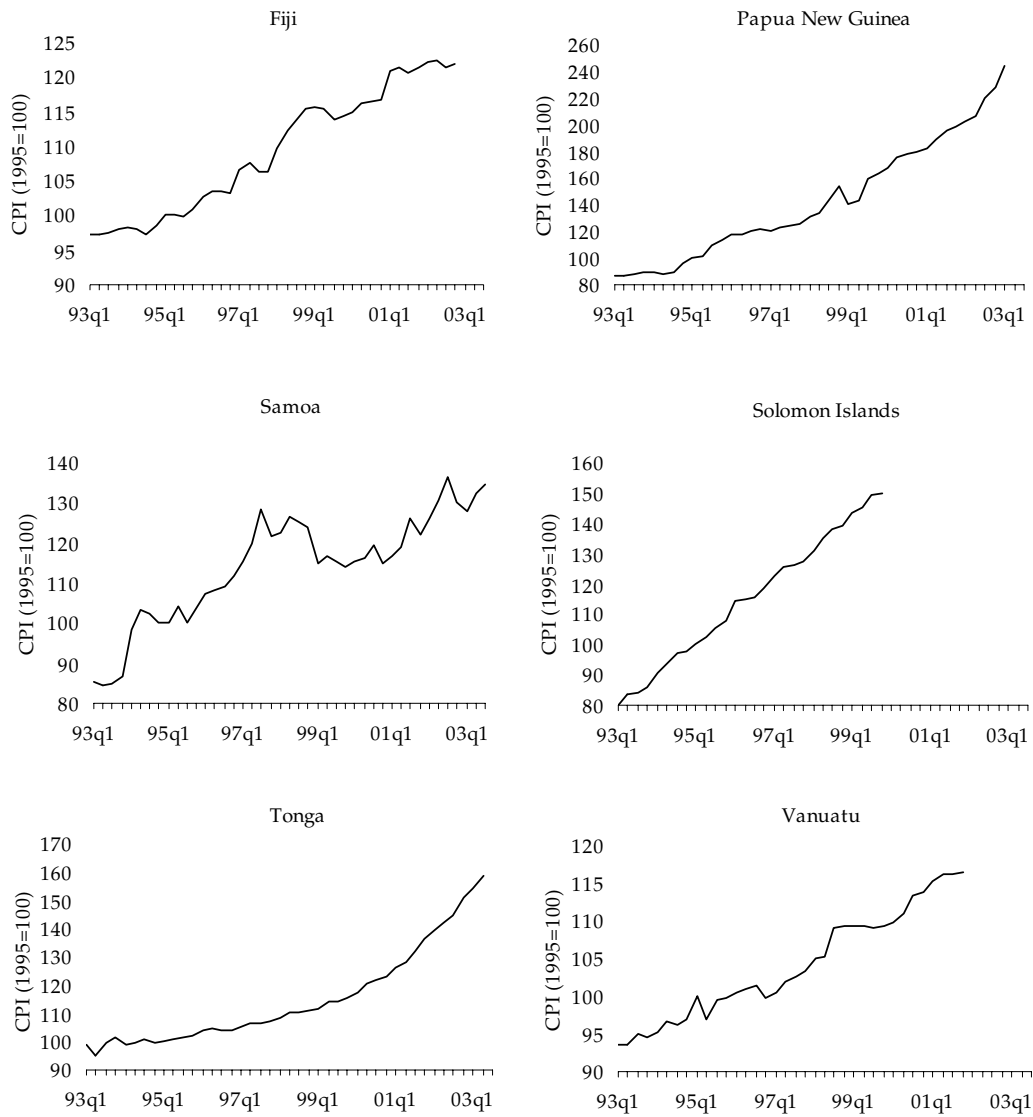

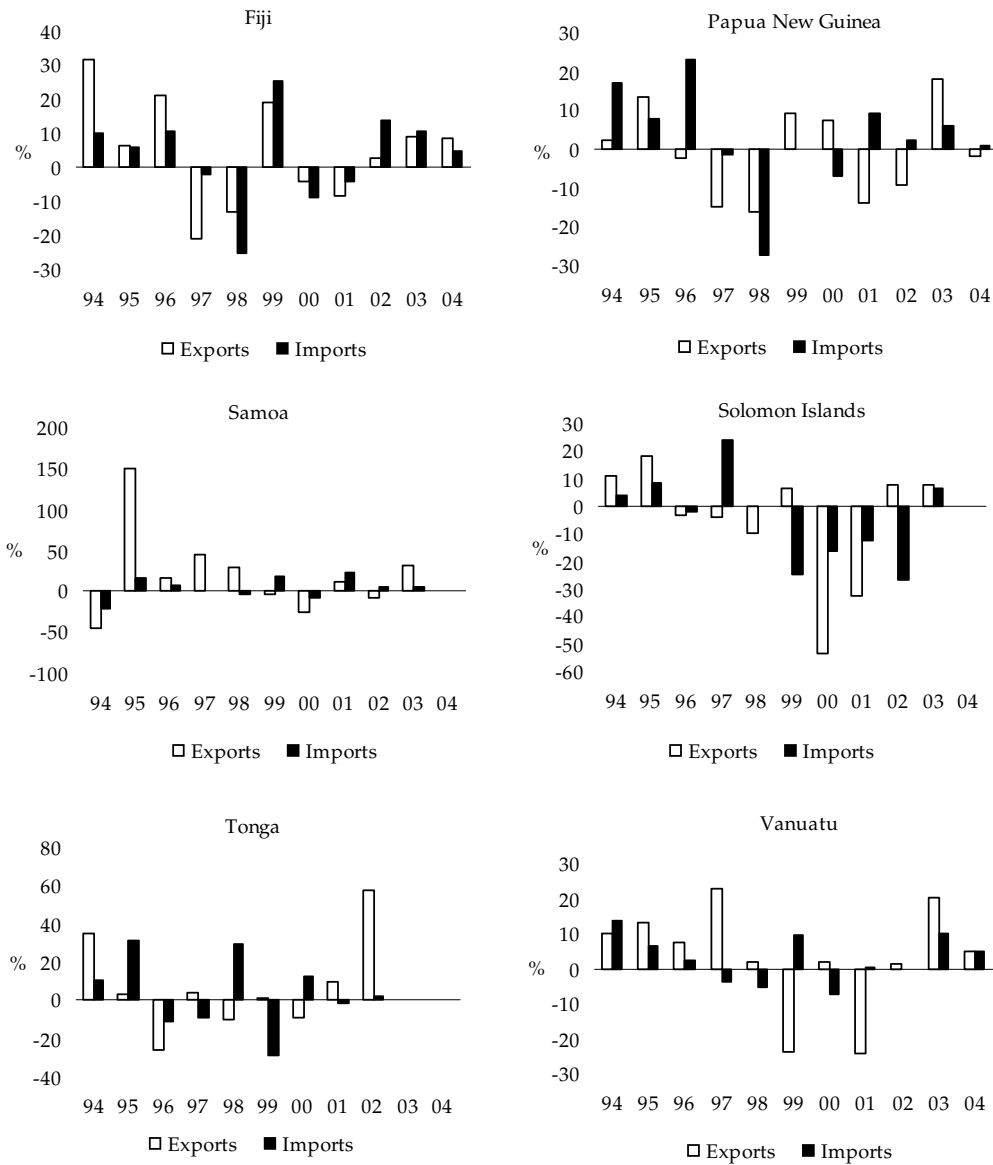
Figure 2 Consumer price quarterly indexes, 1993–2003

Figure 3 Growth in merchandise trade, 1994–2004

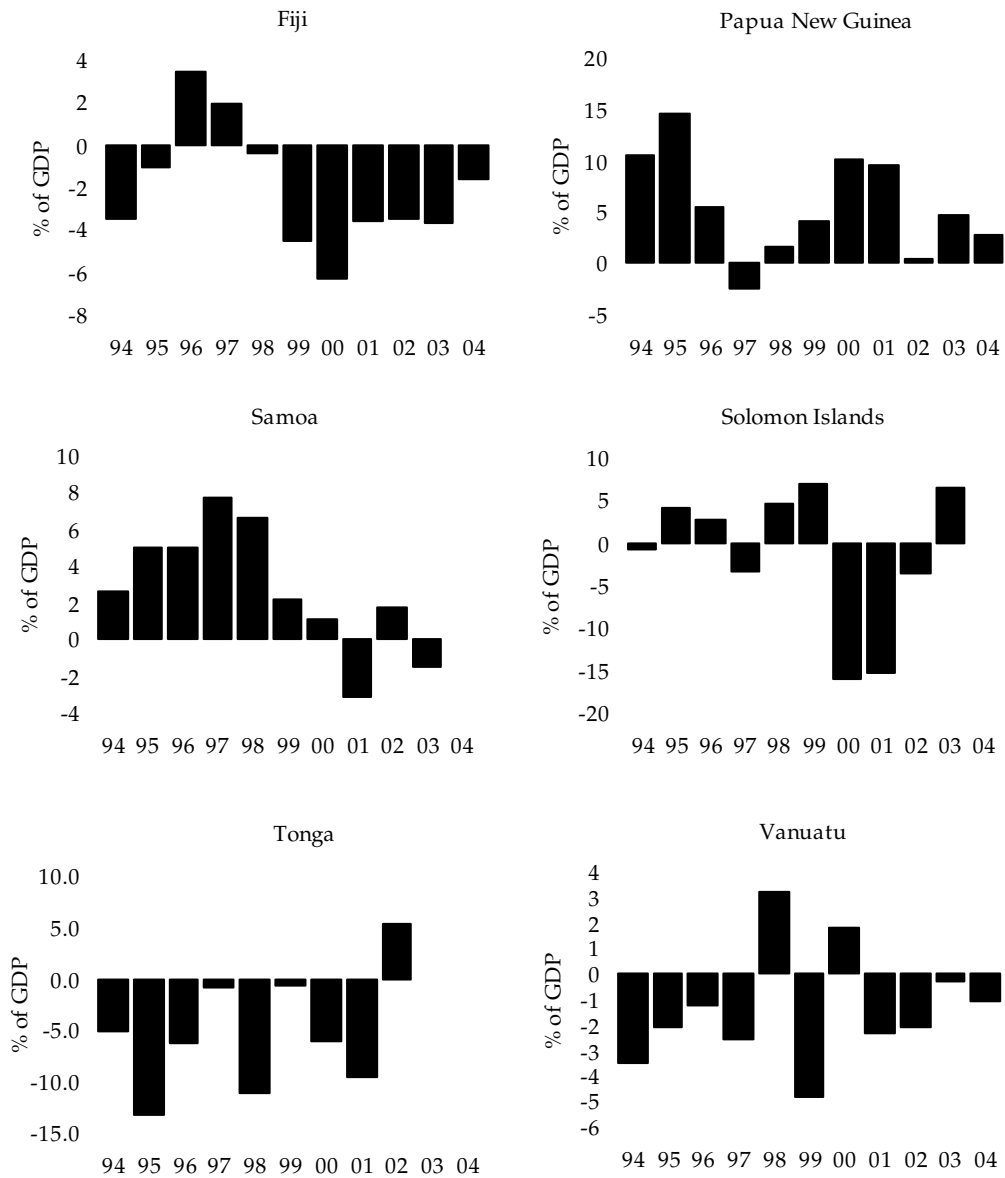

Figure 4 Current account balance, 1994–2004

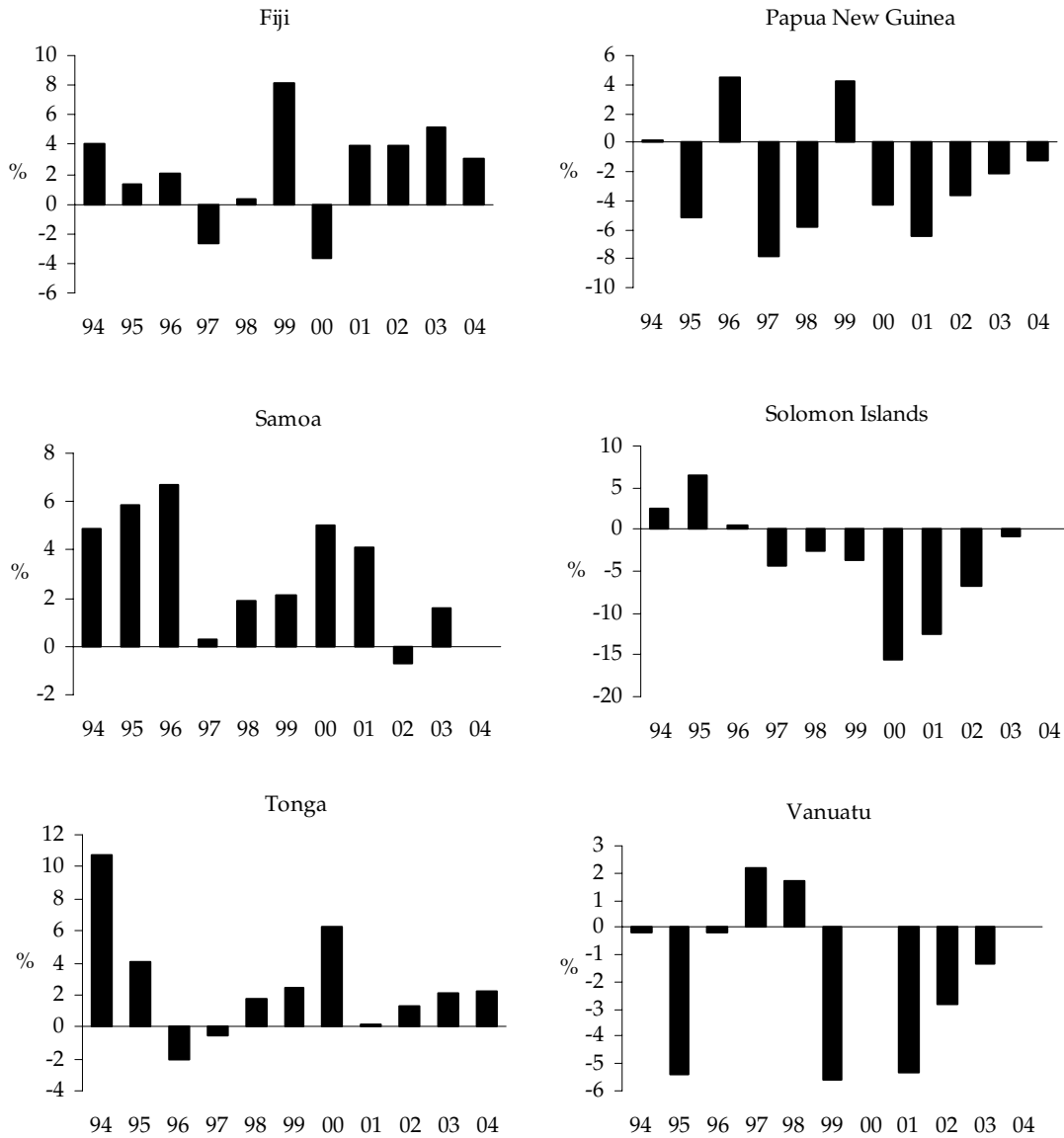

Figure 5 Real GDP growth per capita, 1994–2004

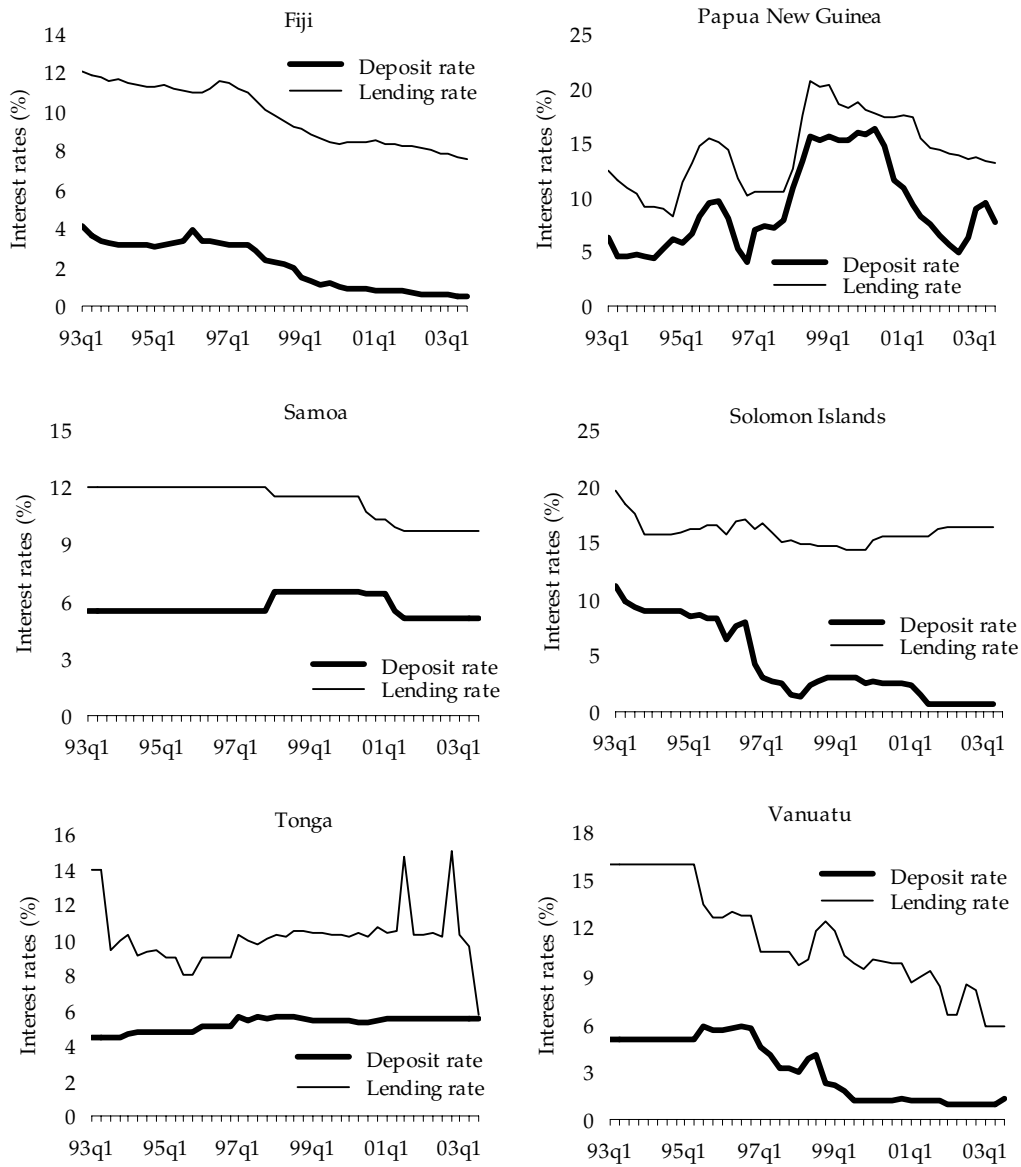

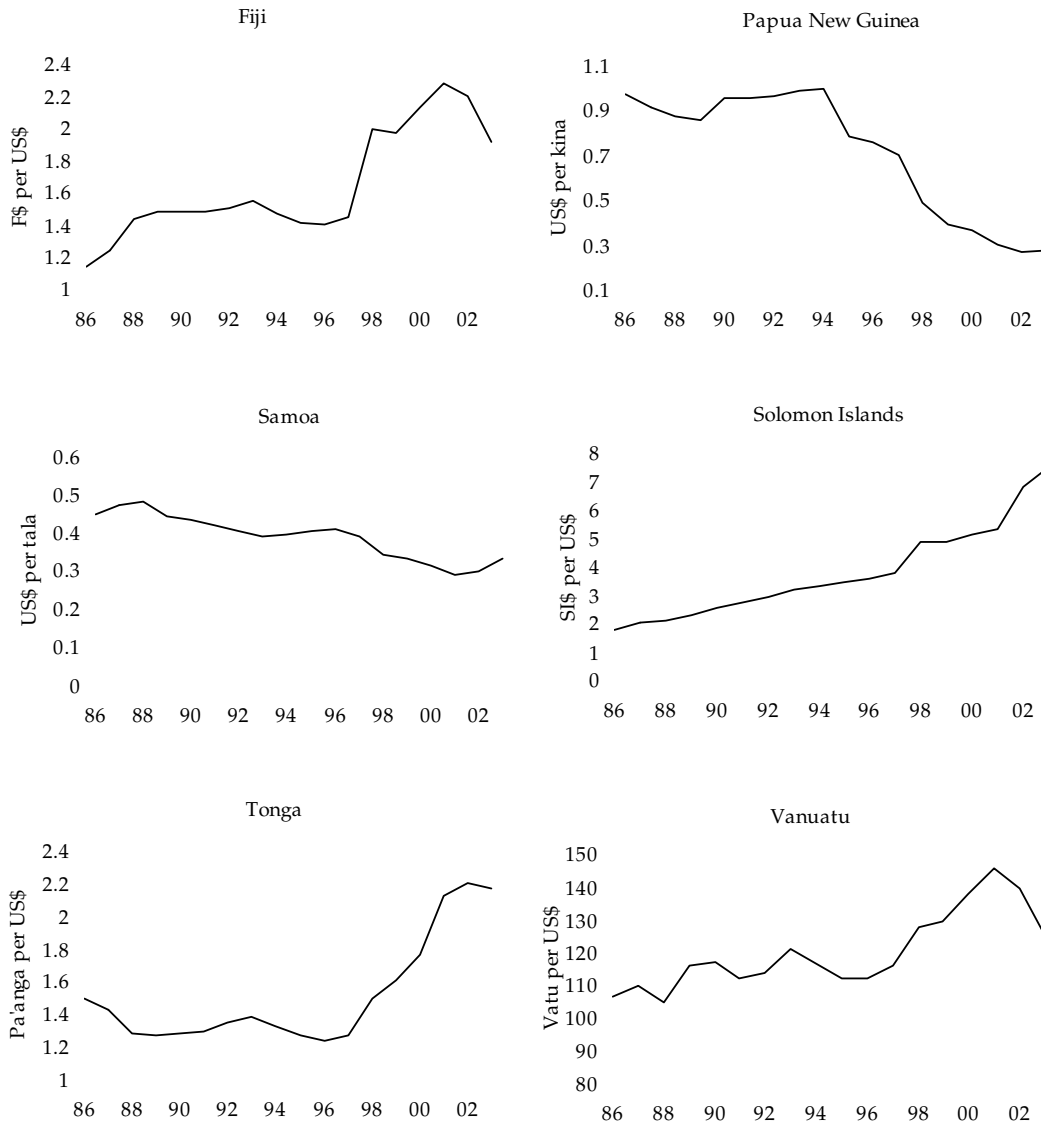
Figure 6 Quarterly interest rates, 1993–2003
