

Department of Public Lands, Portion 6 IT is hereby notified, in pursuance of the provisions of "The Land Acts, 1910 to 1949," that the land specified in the Schedule hereto, and situated in the WINTON LAND AGENT'S DISTRICT, will be open for selection as a GRAZING HOMESTEAD, under the provisions of the said Acts, on TUESDAY, the FOURTEENTH day of MARCH, 1950, at ELEVEN O'CLOCK A.M., at the LAND OFFICE, WINTON, at the annual rent and for the term of lease specified in PARISH OF ELDERSLIE An applicant is required to lodge with his application to select a full year's rent and one-fifth of the survey fee. COUNTY OF ELDERSLIE The maximum area which may be applied for or held by any one person as a Grazing Homestead, in the whole Winton Land Agent's District. The selection shall be stocked to its reasonable carrying capacity with the applicant's own sheep, within a period three years from the date of the license to occupy, and shall thereafter be used for legitimate woolgrowing purposes.
