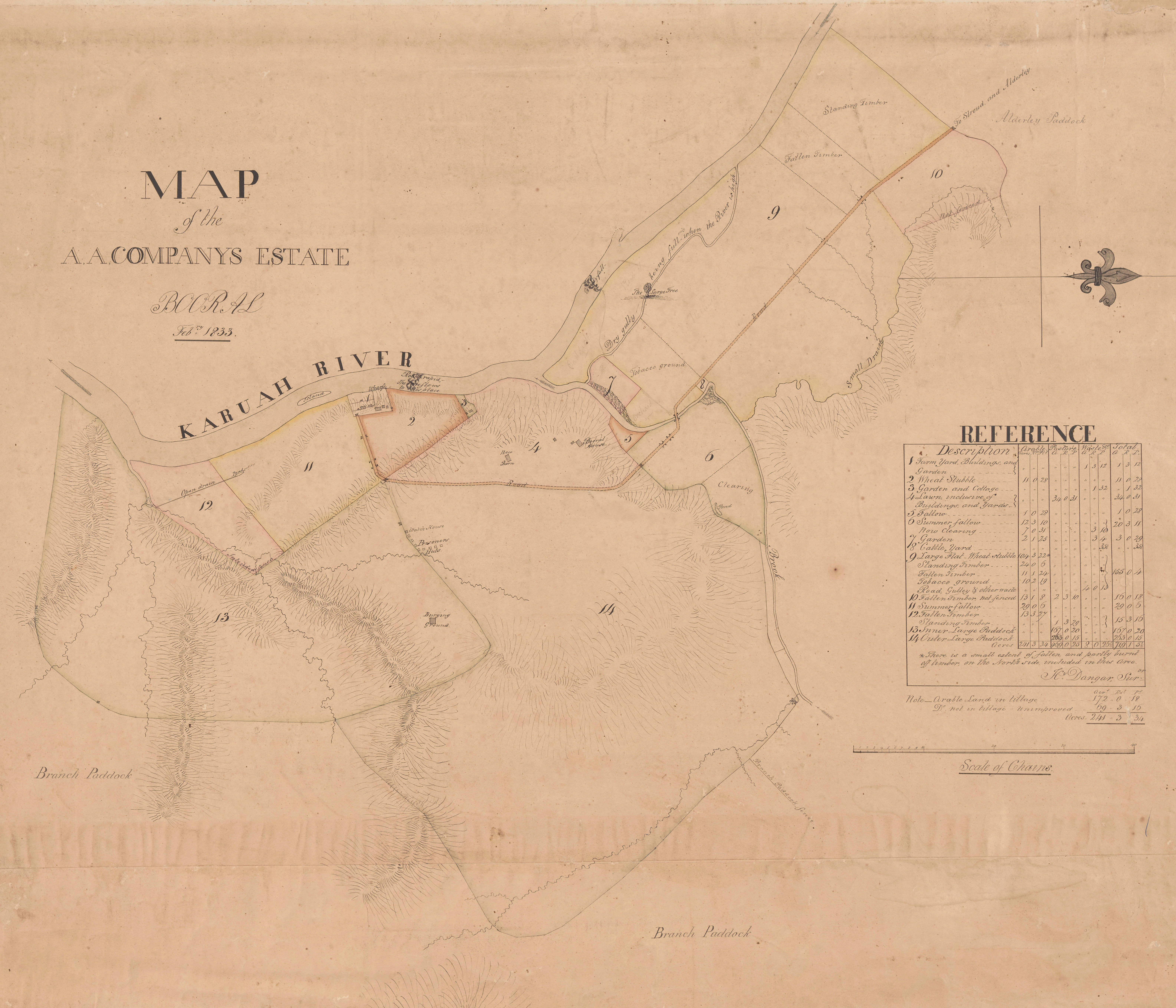


MAP
