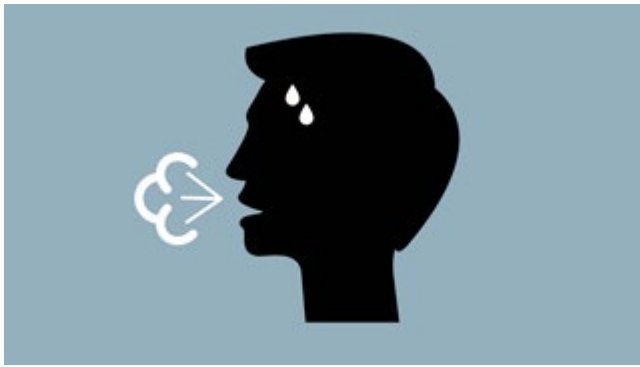


Travel
