


A pocket-sized summary of some of the information contained in the handbook is available on request from the Statistical officer.

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NOTES ON STATISTICAL TERMS

The following notes and list of abbreviations are intended to assist in reading the tables of the handbook and to provide a basic set of definitions of some terms relating to statistical information as they apply within the University.

The kinds of information which can be presented to the user of statistical information depend on the basic data available. In the case of student statistics these data may be grouped into a number of student attributes or characteristics such as sex, age, etc.; details concerning these attributes are recorded at the time of the student's enrolment. In interpreting the figures, it is important to have a clear understanding of what kind of information is described by a particular student attribute. Where necessary, appropriate explanations have been provided in these notes.

Standard definitions and definitions currently in use by the Universities Council generally apply throughout.

academic staff	staff of the SGS at a level of tutor or demonstrator and above, or staff of the IAS at a level of research fellow and above.
affiliated college	a residential college that is affiliated with, but not directly under the control of, the University e.g. Burgmann College, John XXIII College, Ursula College.
annual subject load	total weights of subject units taken by a student.
assisted students	students receiving non-private financial assistance in payment of student body fees.
bachelor honours	students receiving non-private financial assistance in payment of student body fees.
bachelor pass	denotes bachelor courses not included in bachelor honours.
combined course	a program of study leading to two bachelor degrees and requiring generally a minimum of five years' full-time study.
course	a program of study undertaken in one or more faculties, research schools or university centres.

course area	the name given to the student's course or combined course according to the enrolling centre for the course or the area or areas in which the course is undertaken.
course completed	bachelor honours or pass, or higher degree course completed; distinct from degree conferred (e.g. degree is not usually conferred when only the pass component of honours course is completed).
course level	relates to the student's course and comprises nine categories:
	Ph.D., master's degree, master's qualifying, postgraduate diploma, post-bachelor degree, legal workshop, non-degree (postgraduate), bachelor degree, non-degree (undergraduate).
course work	an approved program of study and examination leading to a higher degree, which may include a research component.
current enrolment	any enrolment not cancelled at a specified date.
equivalent full-time student (EFTS)	a student unit calculated thus: $2 \times \text{full-time higher degree enrolments, plus}$ $1 \times \text{part-time higher degree enrolments, plus}$ $1 \times \text{full-time non-higher degree enrolments, plus}$ $1/2 \times \text{part-time non-higher degree enrolments.}$ (Except Legal workshop, the first course of which is weighted by 1 2/3.)
enrolment	generally the formal admission (or re-admission) of a student to a course at the ANU. It may be expressed as enrolment in a course, faculty, department or subject-unit; it excludes 'enrolments' by the Centre for Continuing Education.

faculty	a part of the SGS arising from an administrative classification that is broadly related to field of study. The faculties of the SGS comprise Arts, Asian Studies, Economics, Law and Science.
full-time	denotes a student who is undertaking three-quarters or more of the work prescribed as the requisite or normal full-time course load for a year.
general staff	non-academic staff.
graduate	a student who has been awarded a degree by any recognised university or college of advanced education.
gross enrolments	enrolments counted individually without any adjustment for students with multiple enrolment.
hall of residence	a residential hall that is directly controlled by the University e.g. Bruce Hall, Burton Hall, Garran Hall, University House, Graduate House.
higher degree	denotes courses (or students undertaking such courses) leading towards a higher doctorate, Ph.D. or master's degree. It excludes master's qualifying and similar postgraduate courses.
home residence	the state or country that the student considers to be his permanent home.
home region	a broad categorisation of home residence into major country or region.
intensity	the distinction, in relation to the student's course, between full-time and part-time.
Legal workshop	a course of legal education available to Law graduates which is prescribed as an alternative to articles.


master's degree	denotes courses (or students undertaking such courses) leading to a degree of master by research or by course work. The following degrees of master by course work are currently represented at this University:
	Administrative studies, Agricultural Development Economics, Chinese, Economics, English, Forestry (forest management), International Law Program, Linguistics, Modern European Studies, Prehistory & Anthropology, Psychology (applied), Sociology, Demography, International Relations and Environmental studies.
master's qualifying	see "qualifying".
net enrolments	gross enrolments less an adjustment for multiple enrolment, which is generally the number of undergraduate enrolments arising from postgraduate students enrolling concurrently in undergraduate courses. The adjustment is made to the enrolments at the lowest level.
net total	the total number of net enrolments.
new	means new to course level at the ANU.
new to course level at the ANU	denotes a current enrolment in any undergraduate course, or any postgraduate course at a particular level, for the first time at the ANU.
non-collegiate accommodation	residences, houses or flats operated by the University for group accommodation. e.g. Toad Hall, Corin House, Lennox House "A" Block, Narellan House, Bruce Hall Annex.
non-degree	denotes courses (or student undertaking such courses) not leading specifically towards a degree; it includes enrolments for one or more miscellaneous undergraduate units, and enrolments for some postgraduate courses. It excludes 'enrolments' by the Centre for Continuing Education.
part-time	denotes a student who is undertaking less than three-quarters of the work prescribed as the requisite or normal full-time course load for a year.

post-bachelor degree	denotes a degree course at the level of master's qualifying for which a bachelor degree or equivalent is a prerequisite.
postgraduate	denotes courses (or students undertaking such courses) above the level of bachelor i.e. courses for which a bachelor degree or its equivalent is a prerequisite.
postgraduate diploma	denotes a diploma course at the level of master's qualifying for which a bachelor degree or equivalent is a prerequisite.
qualifying	denotes master's qualifying courses (or students undertaking such courses) prescribed as a prerequisite for a master's degree course.
re-enrolment	a current enrolment which is not new.
reference date	the date to which the statistics relate; if not otherwise indicated, the reference date is 30 April.
research school	a part of the IAS arising from an administrative classification that is broadly related to field of study. The research schools of the IAS comprise RSBS, RSC, RSES, JCSMR, RSPacS, RSPhysS and RSSS.
research only staff	staff employed primarily in research work.
semester unit	a course enrolment offered by some faculties for a period of one semester; that is, generally a half-year's work or less.
staff	members of the staff of the ANU.
student	a person who has been admitted for the current year to a course or courses at the ANU.
student load	a measure of the load placed on the teaching resources of University departments that is directly attributable to student enrolment; it is expressed in terms of and is generally synonymous with WSU.
subject (1)	a course element offered by the Faculty of Law.
subject (2)	a term vaguely used to denote a field of study in which one or four years' undergraduate study may be undertaken; e.g. French, English, Botany are subjects.

subject unit	generally an annual unit, a semester unit, a half-unit, a half-point (quarter) unit, a subject (!) or a final year honours course.
term residence	the place where a student lives for all or a greater part of the academic year.
undergraduate	denotes any bachelor degree course or any other tertiary course for which a bachelor degree or its equivalent is not a prerequisite.
unit	a general term which when unqualified usually means subject unit.
University centres	a branch of the University comprising a number of centres (e.g. CCE, CRES, ORAM) whose primary function is research or service but which may supervise postgraduate students.
wastage	the result of subtracting from the enrolments in a particular year the number of graduating students in that year and the number of re-enrolling students of the following year.
Weighted Student Unit	a unit of measure of student load calculated from departmental undergraduate subject unit enrolments and postgraduate student enrolments; for undergraduates, each subject unit is weighted by the proportion that the subject unit represents of what is considered to be a year's work for a full-time undergraduate; for postgraduates, students are weighted in the same way as in EFTS calculation.
year	if unqualified, refers to a calendar year.
year of study	the year (first, second, etc.) of a student's study at the ANU, based on the calendar year of his first enrolment; precisely it is the number of years plus one that have elapsed since the student first enrolled.




FIG.1 TOTAL ENROLMENT 1962-79 BY INTENSITY




FIG. 2 TOTAL WEIGHTED STUDENT UNITS SGS 1975-79




FIG. 3 POSTGRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE ENROLMENT 1979







FIG. 4 AGE DISTRIBUTION 1979
