



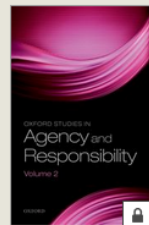

This brief introduction summarizes the motivation collecting these chapters together, which is the fiftieth anniversary of the publication of P. F. Strawson's 1962 paper, "Freedom and Resentment"—as well as the content of each contribution. The chapters fall into three rough categories: (1) those that are primarily interpretive, (2) those that critically examine Strawson's central thesis that there is an intimate connection between the reactive attitudes and interpersonal relationships, and (3) those that explore Strawsonian themes that go somewhat beyond the issues that Strawson himself treats in his essay.

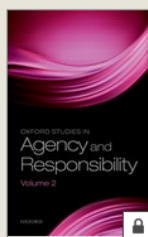
