

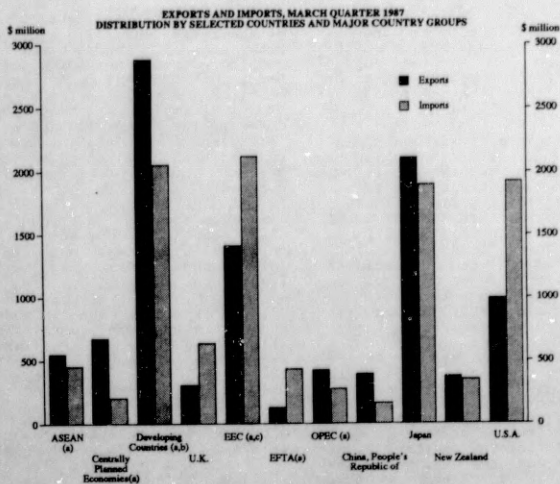


EXPORTS AND IMPORTS AUSTRALIA: TRADE WITH SELECTED COUNTRIES AND MAJOR COUNTRY GROUPS MARCH QUARTER 1987

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NOTE: Export statistics relate to the calendar month in which export entries are lodged with Customs. Import and import clearance statistics relate to the calendar month in which import entries are finalised by Customs. Export and import statistics for a particular month therefore do not necessarily represent goods actually shipped in that month. See paragraphs 5 to 8 of the Explanatory Notes.

MAIN FEATURES

The balance of trade (the difference between exports and imports) moved from a surplus of \$1m for the December quarter 1986 to a deficit of \$481m for the March quarter 1987. This compares with the deficit of \$166m for the March quarter 1986. The deficit for the three quarters ending March 1987 was \$1,744m, which compares with the deficit of \$1,234m for the three quarters ending March 1986.

The change in the balance of trade between December quarter 1986 and March quarter 1987 resulted mainly from the smaller surpluses in trade with Japan and New Zealand and from the larger deficits in trade with the EEC and EFTA.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

A brief outline of the major definitions used in compiling the statistics in this publication is contained in the following explanatory notes and in table footnotes. For a more detailed description refer to the information paper Foreign Trade Statistics: An Overview (5481.0).

2. This publication contains quarterly statistics of Australia's trade with selected major trading partners and groups of countries significant to Australia's trading pattern. The statistics are classified by Sections (1 digit) and Divisions (2 digit) of the Australian Export (AEC) and Import (AIC) Commodity Classifications (1203.0 and 1204.0), both of which have been based since 1 July 1978 on the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) Revision 2.

3. The value of exports is the free on board (FOB) value of the goods expressed in Australian dollars. The recorded value of imports is the Customs value (formerly referred to as the value for duty).

4. In accordance with United Nations recommendations, total exports and imports exclude transactions of non-merchandise trade. Refer to Section 9(b) of the AEC/AIC for a complete list of commodities comprising non-merchandise trade.

5. Exports are recorded statistically in the month when the entries are lodged with the Australian Customs Service. Regular exporters or their agents may provide details of their export shipments on a periodic rather than an individual shipment basis by submitting weekly or monthly returns. These "periodic returns" must be submitted to the Australian Customs Service within seven days of the end of the period in question covering all shipments during that period. All other exporters are required to report each individual shipment prior to the ship's departure. Approximately 90 per cent of monthly export values are recorded on periodic returns. The statistical month for Customs exports (generally ports other than those at which the main Customs office in each State is located) closes on the 21st of each month, whereas for mainports the statistical month is the calendar month.

6. Because of the way in which exports data are collected and processed approximately 40% of total export trade by value shown for a particular month reflects actual shipments in that month, while approximately 55% reflects actual shipments during the previous month with

the remaining 5% by value exported in earlier months. For individual commodities these percentages may vary considerably.

7. Imports are recorded statistically in the calendar month in which the import entries are both finalised by the Australian Customs Service and passed to the ABS for further processing. Import entries may be lodged early using the Customs check-to-arrive system or the documents may be delayed because of various validation checks carried out by Customs prior to the entries being passed to the ABS.

8. Import statistics for a particular month do not necessarily represent entries lodged or commodities actually imported during that month. Analysis of past data has shown that in aggregate approximately 70 per cent of import trade by value for a particular month reflects actual imports during that month, 25 per cent by value was actually imported during the previous month with the remaining 5 per cent by value imported in earlier months. For individual commodities the percentage by value representing actual imports in a month may vary considerably.

9. Restrictions are placed on the release of statistics for certain commodities for reasons of confidentiality. These restrictions do not affect total export and import figures, but they can affect statistics at all levels of the AEC and AIC. Refer to Appendices B and C for details. The information paper Confidentiality and The Release of Foreign Trade and Shipping Statistics (5486.0) describes fully the confidentiality process.

10. Revisions to previously published data frequently occur due to continuing data quality checks and statistics for 1985-86 and 1986-87 may be subject to revision as a result.

11. For exports, country refers to the country to which the goods were consigned at the time of export. For imports, country refers to the country of origin of the goods, defined as the country of production for Customs purposes.

12. The country groups shown in this publication are selected economic groups with which Australia trades, namely:

Association of South-East Asian Nations (ASEAN)
Centrally Planned Economies (CPE'S)
Developing Countries (DC'S)
European Economic Community (EEC)
European Free Trade Association (EFTA)
Organisation of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC)

A list of the countries included in each of the above groups is shown in Appendix A. Country groups may not be mutually exclusive e.g. Indonesia is included in OPEC, ASEAN and as a Developing Country.

13. The statistics shown refer to the value of exports and imports recorded during the period specified (excluding non-merchandise trade). The excess of the value of exports over imports in Table 1 represents the balance of trade on a recorded trade basis. This is not the same as the balance of trade on a balance of payments basis.

14. It should be noted that the export and import figures designated total are the total trade for Australia and not the sum of the trade with the particular countries and country groups specified in this publication.

15. Export and import statistics are also available on microfiche, special returns, and magnetic tape. A comprehensive series of information papers describes these services. For more information, please contact any ABS office.

EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DECEMBER 1985 TO MARCH 1987

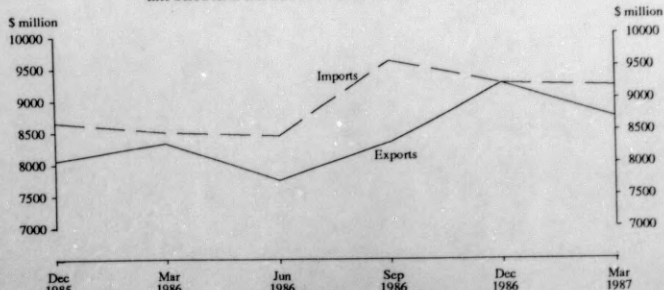
