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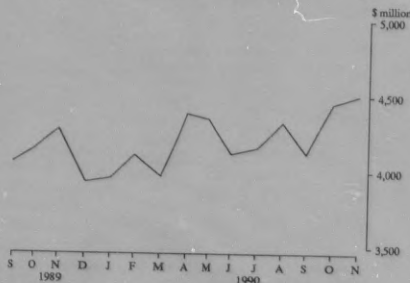
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MAIN FEATURES

TOTAL MONTHLY EXPORTS



Exports for November 1990 were \$4,506m, an increase of \$55m compared with October 1990.

Major increases were recorded in non-metallic mineral manufactures, up \$51m (128%) to \$91m; gold coin, up \$26m (334%) to \$34m; and road vehicles, up \$23m (42%) to \$76m. Decreases were recorded in coal, coke and briquettes, down \$78m (14%) to \$488m; and metalliferous ores, down \$46m (7%) to \$649m.

Australia's major exports for November 1990 and their principal markets were:

- coal (excluding coke and briquettes) (\$480m): Japan (57%), the Republic of Korea (8%) and Taiwan (6%);
- non-monetary gold (\$406m): Switzerland (36%), Japan (31%), and Singapore (13%);
- meat of bovine animals (\$232m): U.S.A. (42%), Japan (38%) and the Republic of Korea (6%);
- petroleum oils (\$210m): Indonesia (30%), Singapore (30%) and the U.S.A. (24%).

PERCENTAGE CONTRIBUTION OF SELECTED MAJOR COMMODITIES TO TOTAL EXPORTS

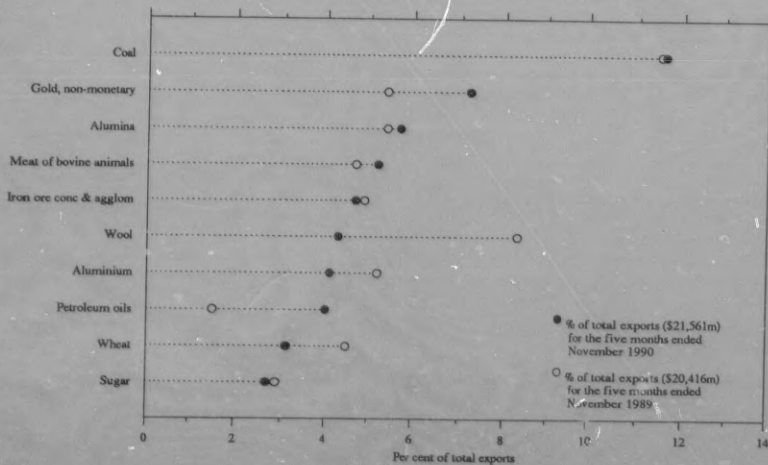

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

A brief outline of the major definitions used in compiling the statistics in this publication is contained in the following explanatory notes and in table footnotes. For a more detailed description refer to the information paper *Foreign Trade Statistics: An Overview* (5481.0).

Introduction of EXIT (Exports Integration)

2. On 12 December 1988 the Australian Customs Service (ACS) commenced the progressive implementation of EXIT, a new system for electronically processing and recording export information and for clearance of outward sea and air cargo manifests.

3. The EXIT system will lead to an improvement in timing of exports in foreign trade statistics. Presently, exports are recorded in foreign trade statistics in the month the export documents are processed by ACS. When EXIT is fully operational, exports will be recorded in the month of shipment and consequently foreign trade export statistics will more accurately reflect actual shipments departing during that month. For further details see paragraphs 17 to 20 below.

Next release date

5. The December 1990 issue of this publication is expected to be released in early March 1991.

Statistical Concepts

6. The merchandise export statistics in this publication are compiled in broad agreement with the United Nations' recommendations for the compilation of international trade statistics. Merchandise exports covers all movable goods which subtract from Australia's stock of material resources. Non-merchandise trade is excluded (see paragraphs 14 and 15) as are goods moving temporarily through Australia, e.g. transit trade.

7. The merchandise export statistics in this publication are recorded on a general trade basis, i.e. exports include both Australian produce and re-exports.

8. Australian produce is defined as goods, materials or articles which have been produced or manufactured in Australia. Processing and assembly operations that leave imported components and products essentially unchanged are not considered as production or manufacture.

9. Re-exports are defined as goods, materials or articles originally imported into Australia which are exported in the same condition or after undergoing minor operations (e.g. blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, husking and shelling) which leave them essentially unchanged.

Scope and Coverage of the Statistics

10. For details of those goods excluded from merchandise trade, either because they are not within the scope of merchandise trade or for which practical difficulties prevent their measurement, see paragraph 9 of the Ex-

planatory Notes of the 1989-90 issue of the publication *Foreign Trade, Australia, Exports* (5436.0).

Commodity Classifications

11. Commodity export statistics in Tables 2 to 4 of this publication are presented according to the codes and descriptions of the United Nations' Standard International Trade Classification Revision 3 (SITC Rev 3) with the addition of dummy codes to take account of Australia's treatment of gold and other legal tender coin and confidential items.

12. Statistics in Table 7 are presented according to the categories of the United Nations' classification, Broad Economic Categories (BEC). The BEC classifies foreign trade statistics according to the main end use of the commodities traded.

Industry of Origin

13. Export statistics in Table 6 are classified by subdivisions of the Australian Standard Industrial Classification (ASIC). Commodities classified to statistical items of the Australian Harmonized Export Commodity Classification are allocated to the ASIC industry of origin whose main economic activities are primarily associated with those commodities.

Non-merchandise trade

14. Non-merchandise exports consist primarily of re-exports of goods which were originally imported on a temporary basis (e.g. goods for public exhibition in Australia or for repair, alteration or renovation in Australia) and subsequently re-exported.

15. The monthly value of non-merchandise trade is shown in Table 1. Further information on the value of the commodities which comprise non-merchandise exports is available on Microfiche MX07.

Valuation

16. The value of exports is the free on board (FOB) transactions value of the goods expressed in Australian dollars.

Time of recording

17. Exports still lodged via the paper based system are generally recorded statistically in the month the entries are processed by ACS. Regular exporters or their agents may provide details of their export shipments on a periodic rather than an individual shipment basis by submitting weekly or monthly returns. These 'periodic returns' must be submitted to the ACS within seven days of the end of the period in question covering all shipments departing during that period. All other exporters are required to report each individual shipment prior to the ship's departure. Approximately 90 per cent of monthly export values lodged via the paper based system are recorded on periodic returns. The processing month for Customs outports (generally ports other than those at which the main Customs office in each state is located) closes on the 21st of each month, whereas for mainports the processing month is the calendar month.

18. Because of the post-shipment lodgment of the periodic returns, entries processed by ACS in any month will include, for mainports, weekly returns for the fourth week of the previous calendar month and the first three weeks of the current calendar month. Monthly returns processed relate to the preceding calendar month's trade. Outport returns will be processed with the additional delay associated with the earlier close off of the processing month. When returns are lodged late, and the amounts involved are significant, the returns are processed as revisions to the statistical month in which they should have been reported.

19. The way in which exports data lodged via the paper based system are collected and processed, means that approximately 40 per cent of total export trade by value shown for a particular month reflects actual shipments departing during that month, while approximately 55 per cent reflects actual shipments departing during the previous month with the remaining 5 per cent by value departing in earlier months. For individual commodities these percentages may vary considerably.

20. In order to maintain a consistent time series during the period when EXIT is progressively introduced, export information reported electronically is adjusted to record it in foreign trade export statistics in the statistical period in which it would have been recorded under the paper based system. This adjustment will be made for an interim period. After EXIT is fully operational the export series will be compiled on a shipping date basis.

Country statistics

21. Country statistics shown in Tables 3 and 9 refer to the country to which the goods were consigned at the time of export.

22. Data for countries and country groups for all time periods included in this publication reflect the composition of those countries and country groups on the last day of the reference period of this publication. For example in October 1990 the Federal Republic of Germany (FDR) and the German Democratic Republic (GDR) joined together and the united entity is referred to in ABS foreign trade publications as Germany. Therefore exports for prior periods to the separate areas that were FDR and GDR are now combined and recorded as exports to Germany.

Confidentiality

23. Restrictions are placed on the release of statistics for certain commodities for reasons of confidentiality. These restrictions do not affect total export figures, but they can affect statistics at all levels in country and commodity tables. Refer to table footnotes and the Appendix for specific details. More details on the confidentiality process can be obtained from the Confidentiality Manager on Canberra (06) 252 5425.

Reliability

24. Statistics in this publication for recent periods should be considered preliminary. Revisions to previously published data frequently occur due to continuing data quality checks.

Relationship to balance of payments statistics

25. The basic source of balance of payments data on merchandise exports and imports is 'foreign trade statistics'. However, because of conceptual differences, various coverage, timing and (imports only) valuation adjustments are necessary before foreign trade statistics can be put on a balance of payments basis. For more information on the relationship between merchandise trade measures in foreign trade and balance of payments statistics see either *Foreign Trade Australia: Comparative and Summary Tables* (\$410.0) or Chapter 9 of *Balance of Payments, Australia: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (\$331.0).

Foreign Trade services available on request

26. Special Returns service. This service provides commodity-based foreign trade statistics tailored to users' requirements. The data are available on computer printout or via the electronic mail service, TELESTATS. Charges for this service depend on the level of detail required. Further details are available from the **Special Returns Managers** on Canberra (06) 252 5404 (exports) or 252 5408 (imports).

27. Microfiche service. A variety of tabular formats is available covering commodities exported or imported at various levels of aggregation. Further details are available from **Information Services** in each ABS office.

28. Magnetic Tape service. Foreign trade statistics are also available on 9 track magnetic tape. This service is recommended where users wish to obtain trade data at the most detailed level. Further details are available from the **Tape Production Managers** on Canberra (06) 252 5968 (exports) or 252 5417 (imports).

29. Other foreign trade data services. A wide variety of customised data services is available on an ad hoc or subscription basis. Data can be provided on printout or floppy disk or via electronic mail. Further information about these services is available from the **Dissemination Managers** on Canberra (06) 252 5400 (exports) or 252 5422 (imports).
