EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains statistics on the intake of whole milk and the sales of market milk by factories. These statistics have been collected by the Australian Dairy Corporation (ADC) and replace statistics of whole milk production previously compiled by the ABS.

2. The series previously compiled by the ABS has been discontinued. For a comparison of that series with the series now being published, see the September issue of this publication (7208.0) released on 5 December 1980.

Seasonal adjustment

3. Table 2 includes seasonally adjusted figures for the ADC series whole milk intake by factories. In the seasonal adjustment, account has been taken of normal seasonal factors and of trading-day effects because the quantity of milk used for butter and cheese making is derived from the factory production of butter and cheese. Details of the methods used in seasonally adjusting these and other series are contained in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, Australia* (1308.0).
