

**COMMERCIAL FINANCE, AUSTRALIA
DECEMBER 1989**

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MAIN FEATURES

Commercial finance commitments made by significant lenders in December 1989 totalled \$6,959.7 million, \$71.5 million (1.0%) less than in November 1989 and \$1,948.9 million (21.9%) less than in December 1988. December 1989 and December 1988 were four week reporting periods for some banks compared with a five week period in November 1989.

Commitments under fixed loan facilities were down \$624.7 million (19.5%) on November 1989 in virtually all industries, the exception being wholesale trade, which recorded an increase.

The decrease in fixed loan facilities in December 1989 were offset to a large extent by an increase in lending commitments under revolving credit facilities of \$553.2 million (14.5%). The increase was not general across borrowing industries; for example in the mining industry there was a decrease of \$135.8 million (67.1%) while in wholesale trade there was an increase of \$262.3 million (129.5%) and in finance, investment and insurance an increase of \$632.7 million (92.1%).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication presents statistics of commercial finance commitments made by significant lenders to government, private and public enterprises, and non-profit organisations as well as to individuals (for investment and business purposes). Please note that lease finance commitments are excluded (refer *Lease Finance, Australia*, 5644.0). For detailed information on scope and coverage of these statistics and definitions of data items, refer to the July 1988 issue of this publication.

Statistical period

2. While the statistics are described as being for calendar months, it should be noted that:

- in the case of trading banks, the data relate to a month ending on the last Wednesday;
- in the case of other lenders, some have accounting periods which do not correspond exactly to a calendar month and their figures are used without adjustment.

Unpublished data

3. More detailed classifications of the data in this publication may be made available on request. Generally a

Revisions

4. Revisions to previously published statistics are included in issues of this publication as they occur.

Total credit limits at end of period

5. In principle, total credit limits at the end of period for revolving credit presented in Table 4 are derivable by adding new and increased lending commitments during the period less cancellations and reductions of credit limits during the period to the balance of credit limits at the end of the previous period. In practice, however, revisions and other adjustments such as the transfer of an existing fixed credit facility to a revolving credit facility will mean that such a derivation is inexact.
