EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. The Bulletin contains statistics of production in Australia of mine and factory products for which monthly figures are available. An alphabetical index of these products is given on page 2.
2. For each product annual totals for the last three complete financial years are shown in conjunction with (a) totals for the most recent six-monthly and three-monthly periods together with similar figures for the same periods, twelve months earlier and (b) monthly totals for each of the latest fourteen months (where available).
3. The annual totals for the years 1960-61 and 1961-62 are mostly derived from the annual factory returns collected by the Deputy Commonwealth Statistician in each State and are final. It should be noted that in some cases, returns are accepted from factories for a year other than the normal financial year ending on 30th June.
4. The monthly figures are also based for the most part on returns collected by the Deputy Commonwealth Statisticians. Where another authority is the source, this is shown in a footnote. Monthly figures from July, 1962 onwards may be revised when the results of the Annual Factory Returns for 1962-63 become available.
5. For the purpose of factory statistics collections, a factory is taken to be a manufacturing establishment in which four or more persons are employed or in which power other than manual is used; any production in small establishments not classified as factories is not included in the figures shown herein.
6. Further detail in respect of many of the items will be found on an annual basis in the Secondary Industries Bulletin and the series of Manufacturing Industries Bulletins published by this Bureau and on a monthly basis, in the Monthly Production Summaries, also issued by this Bureau.

PERSONS USING THIS BULLETIN ARE ASKED TO NOTE PARTICULARLY THE FOLLOWING:-

1. The Monthly Bulletin of Production Statistics contains data of monthly output of over 300 individual factory products. As monthly particulars of additional items are collected and become available for publication, they will be included in the Bulletin. The items for which quantity of output is published herein are not, however, selected as representative of all factory output. In practice, it is not possible to make such a selection at present.
2. The tables should be read only as showing monthly trends in output of the individual items or groups of items listed. They have not been summarized into a monthly index of Volume of Factory Output, nor a monthly index of Industrial Production, because they cannot be assumed to be representative of total trends in volume of factory output or volume of industrial production. It is, in fact, improbable that they are continually representative in this sense.
3. Although the list of items in these monthly tables includes only a small proportion of all the items produced in factories, it nevertheless relates directly to items accounting for possible up to 40 per cent. of total value of factory output.
4. Comparable annual data of quantity of output are collected at present for a longer list of items covering about one-half of factory production, measured in gross value of output, or slightly less (about 45 per cent.) measured in terms of net value of output or "value added" by process of manufacture. Among the factors limiting useful extension in the annual collection of factory output (in quantitative terms) into the field as yet unrecorded in that way are: (i) the fact that a large part of factory production cannot be expressed in quantity terms but only as a gross or net value of output; (ii) the great and growing diversity of factory products; and (iii) the absence of homogeneity in many types of factory products.
