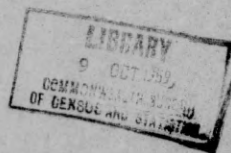

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PREFACE

This bulletin contains statistics for the year 1958 relating to staff, students, and degrees conferred at the Universities of Sydney, Melbourne, Queensland, Adelaide, Western Australia, Tasmania, New South Wales and New England (Armidale, New South Wales), and the Canberra University College. Particulars of the Australian National University (Canberra) are included only in Tables 24 to 31 inclusive. Particulars of the Newcastle University College are included with the University of New South Wales.

The tables present figures on a comparable basis as between Universities or show Australian totals for the years 1954 to 1958 for purposes of comparison. However comparability is affected by factors such as differences and changes in practices in various Universities including re-organizations of faculties and courses and commencement of new courses.

Staff statistics relate to the end of the year to which they refer.
