EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin which is the first in a new quarterly series, contains details of road traffic accidents involving casualties for the year ended December, 1963 and for quarters September, 1963 to September, 1964.

2. Except as mentioned in paragraph 3, details of road traffic accidents involving casualties relate to accidents reported to the police, which satisfy the following conditions:

- (a) That the accident occurred on any road, street, thoroughfare, etc. open to the public, including railway level crossing;
- (b) That it involved any road vehicle, i.e. motor car, tram, handbarrow, etc. (or other road user, such as an animal), which at the time of the accident, was in motion;
- (c) That the accident resulted in:
 - (i) the death of any person within a period of 30 days of the accident; or
 - (ii) bodily injury to any person to an extent requiring surgical or medical treatment.

3. For South Australia, particulars of the number of road traffic accidents and the number of persons injured include the number of accidents in which the injured persons did not require surgical or medical treatment, and the number of persons injured in accidents who did not require surgical or medical treatment.

4. The statistics in this bulletin are compiled from accident reports which are prepared by police officers in the various States and Territories.

5. Australian totals of the number of accidents which involved only damage to vehicles are not available because these details are not compiled by all States.

6. Details of road traffic accidents classified according to "Type of Road User Responsible" and "Cause of Accident" are not included in this bulletin. Investigations have shown that, because of the subjective nature of classification of accidents according to "responsibility" and "cause", it has not been possible to collect and classify statistics on the same basis for all States.

7. Statistical statements of road traffic accidents are issued quarterly for the States of Victoria, Queensland and Western Australia and monthly for the State of Tasmania by the respective Deputy Commonwealth Statisticians. The statement for Victoria does not include particulars of road traffic accidents classified according to "Type of Road User Responsible" and "Cause of Accident". Separate publications relating to road traffic accident statistics are not published by the Deputy Commonwealth Statisticians in New South Wales or South Australia. However, in New South Wales the Commissioner of Motor Transport publishes annually a statement entitled "Statistical Statement of Road Accidents in New South Wales", and in South Australia the Commissioner of Police includes particulars of road traffic accidents in the annual "Report of the Commissioner of Police". The Commissioner of Police in the Northern Territory also includes summary particulars of road traffic accidents in the annual "Report of the Commissioner of Police".
