FACTORY STATISTICS : NORTHERN TERRITORY, 1967-68

The statistics relating to factories, as shown in this bulletin, have been compiled from statutory returns supplied annually by manufacturers in the Northern Territory. For statistical purposes, a factory is defined as an establishment in which four or more persons are employed, or where power (other than manual) is used in any manufacturing or repairing process. Further details regarding the scope of the statistics and the definition of items are shown in the annual bulletin "Manufacturing Industry", published by this Bureau.

Table 1 shows the principal factory statistics for 1967-68 in comparison with those for the previous four years. Details for 1967-68 of the classes of industry and selected sub-classes of industry which are available for publication are given in Tables 2 and 3.

Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components in tables are due to rounding.
