AUSTRALIAN OVERSEA TRADE - NOVEMBER, 1932.

The Monthly Summary of Oversea Imports and Exports for November, 1932, has been made available by the Acting Commonwealth Statistician.

THE TRADE POSITION. Both Imports and Exports were high in November, the Imports being 7 per cent. and the Exports 12 per cent. over those of the preceding month. In Merchandise alone, the increase was 7 per cent. for Imports and 15 per cent. for Exports. Exports of Merchandise, valued in Sterling at £8,218,025, were 7 per cent. ahead of those for the corresponding month last year, while for Imports the advance was 59 per cent. As was the case last month, the increase of Imports is chiefly in Production Goods, viz., Cornsacks, Petroleum, Motors, Cotton and Linen Piece Goods, Silk Piece Goods, Cotton Yarns, Tools of Trade, etc.

There was, therefore, a favourable commodity balance of £2,555,000 for the month, as compared with £4,141,000 for the previous November. For the five months ended November, 1932, the commodity balance was £2,656,000 compared with £29,413,000 for the corresponding period of 1931-32; while, taking shipments of Gold into consideration, the favourable balance was £5,076,000 for the five months of the current year, and £11,902,000 for the corresponding period of last year.

MONTHLY EXPORT PRICES. The Export Price Index Number for the month of November, 1932, was 1021 compared with 1067 for the preceding month, and 1066 for the month of November, 1931.

IMPORTS (values in Sterling) during November, 1932, amounted to £5,773,000 (of which £5,663,000 represented Merchandise and £110,000 Bullion and Specie) compared with £5,375,000 in October and £3,624,000 in November of last year. Compared with the corresponding month of last year, Imports increased in all classes except II Foodstuffs of Vegetable Origin £213,771 (£243,314); and IV Tobacco and Preparations thereof £29,097 (£54,118). The greatest increases were in Apparel, Textiles, etc., £2,056,110 (£1,282,804); Metals and Machinery £1,024,745 (£516,457); Oils, Fats and Waxes £470,952 (£291,059); Miscellaneous £301,448 (£152,009); Drugs, Chemicals and Fertilizers £345,123 (£198,998); Paper and Stationery £370,239 (£296,101); Vegetable Substances and Fibres £138,730 (£70,556); Earthenware, Cements, China, Glass and Stoneware £116,526 (£54,576); Wood and Wicker £119,985 (£62,043); Gold and Silver and Bronze Specie £110,112 (£57,330).

For the five months ended 30th November, 1932, Imports amounted to £26,501,000, of which £25,991,000 represented Merchandise and £510,000 Bullion and Specie, in comparison with £17,868,000 (Merchandise £17,615,000; Bullion and Specie £253,000) for the corresponding period of last year. Imports of Merchandise increased by 48 per cent. over the corresponding five months of 1931-32, the classes of Imports showing the highest proportional increases being:- Earthenware, Cements, China, etc., 86%; Drugs, Chemicals, etc., 73%; Metals, Metal Manufactures and Machinery 72%; Spirituous and Alcoholic Liquors 72%; Oils, Fats and Waxes 69%; Wood and Wicker, etc., 68%; Vegetable Substances 63%; Animal Substances 57%; Jewellery, Timepieces, etc., 55%.

The main items showing the greatest absolute increase in value, compared with the corresponding five months of last year, were:- Corn and Flour Sacks £1,631,177 (£769,204); Petroleum £1,647,209 (£951,761); Cotton and Linen Piece Goods £2,578,511 (£2,117,288); Motor Chassis and Parts £575,074 (£116,244); Silk Piece Goods £1,542,492 (£1,265,526); Sulphur £300,980 (£41,944); Gold, Bullion and Specie £490,320 (£245,034); Carpets, Linos, etc., £379,142 (£188,080); Outside Packages £644,814 (£477,765); Fertilizers £373,468 (£207,575); Lubricating (Mineral) Oil £348,215 (£191,774); Timber, Undressed £404,293 (£248,612); Kerosene £289,558 (£156,477). Printing Paper, Arms, Ammunition and Explosives, Piece Goods (Other), Other Metals and Manufactures, Tools of Trade, and Cotton Yarns show increases each of over £100,000.

EXPORTS (values in Australian Currency) of Merchandise in November were £10,314,000 compared with £9,000,000 in October, and £10,053,000 in November, 1931. Exports of Bullion and Specie amounted to £546,000 compared with £706,000 in October, and £750,000 in November of 1931. The total exports were valued at £10,860,000 compared with £9,705,000 in October and £10,802,000 in November, 1931.

When compared with the corresponding month last year, there was an increase in the value of exports of Butter £1,380,409 (£1,242,402); Cheese £48,433 (£17,393); Eggs £196,039 (£136,386); Milk and Cream £121,908 (£54,096); Wheat £892,531 (£583,040); Sheepskins £217,823 (£145,789); Wool, Greasy £4,821,717 (£4,670,879); Sandalwood £18,553 (£3,249); Zinc Ores and Concentrates £11,549 (Nil).

For the five months ended 30th November, 1932, exports of Merchandise totalled £35,952,000 (Australian Currency), equivalent to £28,647,000 Sterling, as compared with £35,240,000 (Australian Currency), equivalent to £27,004,000 Sterling in the corresponding period last year. Bullion and Specie shipped overseas during the five months of 1932-33 amounted to £3,629,361 (Australian Currency) in comparison with £3,523,301 for the corresponding period of 1931-32, the equivalent values in Sterling being respectively £2,930,000 and £2,742,000.

In quantity, compared with the corresponding five months of 1931-32, butter exports were 29 per cent. higher at a reduced price. Cheese increased 49 per cent., but maintained an even price. Beef fell away 28 per cent., but maintained its price. Lamb increased in quantity by 5 per cent., but the price fell. Mutton decreased by 70 per cent., accompanied by a depreciation of price. Although Wheat declined in quantity by 21 per cent., the price increased. Wool, Greasy, increased by 5 per cent. with no alteration in value. Zinc concentrates increased by 144 per cent. with an increase in price; and Zinc bars, blocks, etc., decreased 32 per cent. with an advance in price.

Exports of the following principal items increased in value during the five months ended 30th November, 1932, above that of the exports for the same period last year, viz:- Butter £4,385,666 (£3,758,534); Cheese £113,023 (£76,506); Eggs £848,414 (£458,248); Rabbits and Hares £399,736 (£287,150); Milk and Cream £413,565 (£240,569); Dried Fruits - Raisins, £362,425 (£267,326); Wheat £4,035,940 (£3,648,954); Flour (Wheaten) £1,557,043 (£1,235,124); Sheepskins £705,911 (£653,312); Wool, Greasy £11,841,569 (£11,168,278); Wool, Scoured £1,630,780 (£1,387,983); Sandalwood £55,260 (£26,548); Zinc Ores and Concentrates £56,118 (£23,046); Lead £958,692 (£806,729); Other Metals and Manufactures £160,844 (£105,759); Gold £3,307,097 (£3,276,326).

On the other hand, exports of the following commodities decreased in value during the five months when compared with the corresponding period of 1931-32, viz:- Beef £683,026 (£1,045,205); Lamb £1,314,174 (£1,551,283); Mutton £146,953 (£547,630); Other Meats £177,783 (£235,416); Dried Fruits - Currants £76,043 (£110,375); Citrus Fruits £95,007 (£120,515); Fruits preserved in Liquid £229,713 (£258,904); Barley £11,054 (£36,206); Sugar £1,255,307 (£1,719,823); Other Vegetable Foodstuffs £31,701 (£89,722); Wine £235,758 (£356,989); Opossum Skins £6,208 (£328,771); Rabbit and Hare Skins £268,192 (£402,296); All Hides and Skins £1,243,357 (£1,652,763); Tallow, unrefined £321,488 (£354,704); Coal £121,935 (£150,834); Copper £118,140 (£237,176); Zinc, Bars, Blocks, etc., £231,079 (£340,298); Timber £100,358 (£195,793); Soap £57,098 (£94,567); Bronze Specie £6,354 (£33,057).
