POPULATION COUNT OF CANBERRA, 30TH JUNE, 1964

(FINAL FIGURES)

This bulletin contains final figures from the Population Count of Canberra taken over Tuesday, 30th June and Wednesday, 1st July, 1964. In addition to Tables 1 and 2 for which preliminary figures were given in the statement issued on 10th July, 1964, it contains a table showing the ages of the population. A further table showing ages of the population in each district is available on request (see page 3).

Final figures from the Population Count taken over Tuesday, 30th June and Wednesday, 1st July, 1964 show that the population enumerated in the City of Canberra was 77,644 persons consisting of 40,210 males and 37,434 females, compared with 70,775 persons (36,884 males and 33,891 females) enumerated at the Population Count on 1st July, 1963. These figures are exclusive of diplomatic personnel of overseas countries resident in Canberra at the dates shown. The number of persons excluded in this way at both counts was approximately 1,000.

2. Details of the population, distinguishing those recorded in private dwellings, recorded in each district are shown in the following table.

Of the total private dwellings shown in the table above, 15,657 were houses (including sheds, huts etc.) with 65,181 occupants equivalent to an average of 4.11 occupants per house. Flats numbered 2,203 with 4,822 occupants or 2.19 occupants per flat. Because the manner of taking this count differed from that employed in the 1961

Census or the 1963 Population Count it was not possible to distinguish private houses or flats which were shared. Thus it is not possible to compare the number of dwellings of each class with the numbers recorded in 1961 or 1963.

3. The following table shows the population of each district of Canberra at the Census of 30th June, 1961, and the Population Counts of 1st July, 1963 and 30th June, 1964.

The increase of 6,869 in the population of Canberra in the last twelve months represents a rate of 9.71 per cent.

It is estimated that the population of the Australian Capital Territory including the rural districts was 80,413 persons at 30th June, 1964.

4. At the 1964 Population Count the ages of persons under 21 years of age were recorded in single years; those aged 21 years and over were recorded only as adult. The numbers at these ages as recorded in Canberra at 30th June, 1964 are shown in the following table in comparison with corresponding figures for 1961 and 1963.
