INTRODUCTION

This information paper lists the topics of all monthly supplementary surveys and Special Supplementary Surveys conducted from 1960 to 1985 by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) as part of the Population Survey Program. It also lists the catalogue numbers of the publications which detail the final results of these surveys or, where not yet published, the catalogue numbers of the publications expected to contain the final results of these survey topics. It should be noted that, in many cases, a publication containing preliminary results will also be released some time before the final publication. Preliminary publications have different catalogue numbers and users should refer to the ABS Catalogue of Publications (1101.0) for the catalogue numbers of these preliminary publications.

2. Future Issues of this information paper are expected to be released every two or three years. In the meantime users who require a detailed description of the surveys currently being conducted or those proposed to be conducted during the next twelve to eighteen months should refer to Information Paper: Population Survey Program which is available free, on request, from any ABS Office.

Monthly population surveys

3. Monthly supplementary surveys are conducted in conjunction with the Labour Force Survey (LFS). Together they form, the 'Monthly Population Survey' (MPS). This survey has been conducted since 1960. In early years, the survey was confined to the State capital cities but has been conducted Australia-wide since February 1964. The survey was conducted quarterly until November 1977 and has been conducted monthly since February 1978.

4. A supplementary survey was included with the LFS for the first time in November 1961 and this concept has gradually been extended so that now the majority of months in each year include supplementary questions on one or more topics. Supplementary survey results are generally published separately from those of the LFS.

5. While some of the supplementary survey topics are repeated, care should be taken when comparing estimates for different reference periods because changes in the rules for scope and coverage, the collection of different data items, the use of different questions, etc. may lead to substantial breaks in comparability.

Careful attention should therefore be paid to the explanatory and technical notes which are included in each publication issued from a supplementary survey topic.

6. Also, for a detailed explanation of the sample structure and survey methodology used for the MPS, users should refer to the publications containing LFS results which are included in the list of related publications in paragraph 10 below.

7. Preliminary results of monthly supplementary survey topics are generally published about four to eight months after the survey topic is conducted, while final results are generally published six to twelve months after the survey topic is conducted.

Special Supplementary Surveys (SSS)

8. In addition to the MPS, the ABS conducts Special Supplementary Surveys (SSS's) which differ from the MPS in a number of ways. SSS's provide a vehicle to collect information on more complex topics and, in the case of topics with significant seasonal variations, allow collection over a longer time period. Since 1979, when the term SSS was adopted, one SSS has generally been conducted in each financial year. Prior to 1979, they were conducted on an irregular basis.

9. The timing of the release of results from SSS's varies substantially, because of the usually complex nature of the survey topics and the large amount of information to be made available. However, preliminary results are generally published within twelve months of the survey topic being conducted with final results generally being published within two years of the survey topic being conducted.
