

KIDS NEED TEACHERS NEED JOBS

41,000 children who need intensive migrant or aboriginal English are not getting it.
136,000 children who need remedial maths are not getting it.
143,000 children who need remedial reading are not getting it.

These serious problems largely result from classes that are too big, where teachers can't give enough individual attention.

77% of primary school classes have more than 25 children.
46% of secondary school classes have more than 25 children.

There are thousands of trained teachers who want to teach but are not being employed by State Governments.

TEACHERS NEED JOBS

Even now there are not enough trained teachers available to meet the real needs of children in schools. Yet teacher education numbers are being so severely cut that there will certainly be a serious teacher shortage by the end of the 1980s.
