EXPLANATORY NOTES

This issue of the Review contains a summary of live birth statistics for Australia for the year 1964. Detailed tables will be published later in Demography Bulletin No. 82, 1964.

2. The statistics of births refer to live births registered, during the year shown, by the different State and Territorial Registrars. Stillbirths are excluded from the tables. Because of delays in registration some of these births actually occurred before the year of registration in which they are counted. Information on the date of occurrence of births registered will be published later in the annual bulletin "Demography".

3. In tables 1 - 5, 7, 9 and 10 which relate to "children born", every live-born child is counted as one, whether resulting from a single or a multiple birth. In tables 6, 8 and 11-18 in which the unit is the confinement, every confinement, whether single or multiple, resulting in at least one live birth is counted once only.

4. Confinements, mothers and children are classified as "nuptial" provided that the registered father was married to the mother at the time of the birth, including instances where the husband died during the pregnancy. Other confinements and the children resulting from them are classified as "ex-nuptial", whether or not the parents were living together at the time of the birth and whether or not the child may subsequently have been legitimated or adopted.

5. Particulars of full-blood Aboriginals are excluded from all statistics in this Review.

IN EACH AGE GROUP)

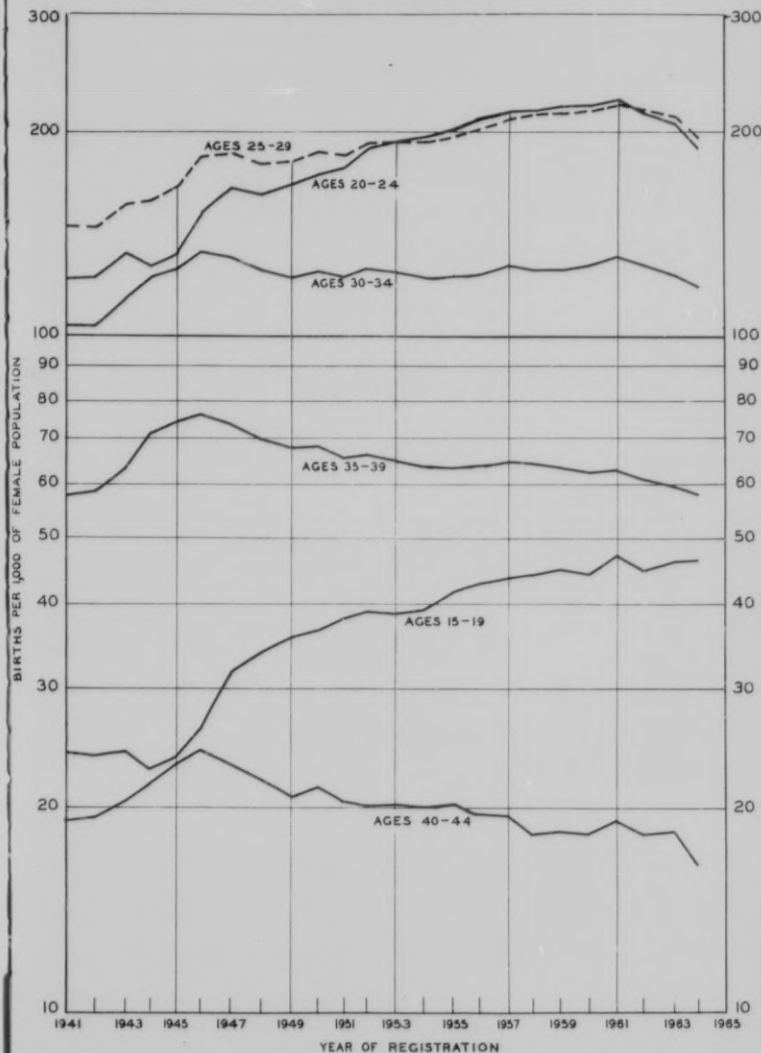
