Sir Lenox Hewitt, until recently Chairman of Qantas and now adviser to Ansett Transport Industries directors, Mr Rupert Murdoch and Sir Peter Abeles, and a director of a number of other companies, will speak and answer questions on aspects of the current debates over Australia's domestic and international airline operations. Sir Lenox is a member of the ANU Convocation of long standing, having been a member of the Council of Canberra University College (which later became part of ANU) and a Lecturer in Economics and Cost Accountancy in the College from 1940-49. year. Sir Lenox was Chairman of the Australian Universities Commission in 1967-68 and has been Secretary of four Commonwealth Government departments, including the Prime Minister's from 1968-71.
