YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE, 1957

This Bulletin contains results, for the State of Victoria, of the Census of Retail Establishments taken in respect of the year ended 30th June, 1957. A more detailed Bulletin for Victoria will be issued later when further tabulations are completed and figures shown in this Bulletin may be subject to minor revision.

In general terms, the Census covered the retail trading activities of establishments which normally sell goods by retail to the general public from shops, rooms, kiosks and yards. Hotels, garages and service stations were also covered and details of their retail sales are included in this Bulletin. Establishments such as licensed clubs, canteens, etc., laundries and dry cleaners, and motion picture theatres were not included in the main Census collection but details of their takings were obtained in supplementary collections and these will be included in later Bulletins. A more detailed description of the scope of the Census will also be given in later Bulletins.

RETAIL SALES OF GOODS 1952-53 TO 1956-57

The following table contains particulars of retail sales of goods for the years 1952-53 to 1956-57 on a comparable basis throughout. The figures for the years 1952-53 and 1956-57 were obtained from Censuses taken in respect of those years whereas figures for the other years shown are estimates based on sample surveys and have been revised since previous publication. Some 1952-53 Census figures have also been revised.

Sales shown in this table have been classified according to the ten commodity groups used in the surveys.

NOTES ON FOLLOWING TABLES

Table I.

This table shows for 1952-53 and 1956-57 the number of establishments selling goods in each of thirty-four broad commodity groups, the total value of these sales and the value of sales per head of population. The commodity groups are listed as they were shown on the Census form and are comparable with groupings used in the 1952-53 Retail Census, with two exceptions. These are -

- (a) in the previous Census, particulars of sales of all electrical goods were collected under one item only i.e. Domestic Refrigerators, Electrical Goods and Accessories, Radios and Musical Instruments. However, in 1956-57 particulars for Victoria have been obtained for five items, namely: Radios, Radiograms and Record Players; Television and Accessories; Musical Instruments, Records, Sheet Music, etc.; Domestic Refrigerators (including non-electrical); Other Electrical Goods and Accessories. A comparison of the sales figures for the two Censuses can be made by amalgamation of these items in 1956-57 but no direct comparison can be made of the number of establishments selling these items.
- (b) in the 1956-57 Census, special queries were sent to all establishments which would normally be expected to sell tobacco, cigars and cigarettes (e.g. grocers, cafes, hairdressers, etc.) but which did not report any sales of these items in their returns. As a result of these queries, 652 additional establishments in Victoria reported sales of Tobacco, Cigars and Cigarettes amounting to £860,000 (2.9 per cent of total sales of Tobacco, Cigars and Cigarettes). Most of these sales had originally been reported as sales of Groceries or Other Types of Food. As these special queries were not made in the 1952-53 Census, it is likely that a small proportion of sales of Tobacco, Cigars and Cigarettes was incorrectly reported in that year, and consequently would be included in the 1952-53 figures for sales of Groceries and other items instead of the figure for sales of Tobacco, Cigars and Cigarettes.

Table II.

This table shows the number of establishments and the value of retail sales for the years 1952-53 and 1956-57, and the value of stocks of goods on hand at 30th June, 1953 and 1957. These details are classified according to type of business.

In classifying establishments to type of business, the description given by the proprietor was used as a guide but the classification was based mainly on the dissection of commodity sales recorded on the Census form. A more detailed description of the method of classification will be given in later Bulletins.

The figures shown for stocks of goods on hand at 30th June, 1953 and 1957 represent the value of goods held for retail sale. They are aggregates of the figures shown on individual returns without any adjustment for different methods of valuation (cost price, market value, replacement cost, etc.)

Table III.

This table shows the number of retail establishments and total value of retail sales for the years 1952-53 and 1956-57, and the total value of retail stocks at 30th June, 1953 and 1957, in each Local Government Area in Victoria. For purposes of the 1956-57 Retail Census the City of Melbourne was sub-divided into two areas, i.e. the Inner City Area and the Remainder of City and separate details are shown for these. For this purpose, the Inner City Area consists of the area bounded by the centres of Flinders; Spring, Latrobe and Spencer Streets. A map of the area will be included in a later Bulletin together with maps of the whole Metropolitan Area and State.

Since the 1952-53 Retail Census some changes have been made to names and boundaries of a number of Local Government Areas. The most significant of these are listed below.

- (a) The part of the Shire of Broadmeadows which was included in the Metropolitan Area in Statistical Retail Area 2005 in 1952-53 has been sub-divided into three sections. One section has been re-named the City of Broadmeadows, another section has been amalgamated with the Shire of Bulla and the remaining section has been amalgamated with the Shire of Whittlesea. The three sections are still included in the Metropolitan Area in the same Statistical Retail Area, viz. 2005.
- (b) The part of the Shire of Broadmeadows which was included in Statistical Retail Area 2103 in 1952-53 has been incorporated with the Shire of Kilmore. The boundaries of Statistical Retail Area 2103 have not changed however, and within this Statistical Retail Area the areas called Kilmore (S) (Part), Bulla (S) (Part) and Whittlesea (S) (Part) in this Bulletin are identical with the areas called Broadmeadows (S) (Part), Bulla (S) and Whittlesea (S) respectively in 1952-53.
- (c) The Shire of Dandenong included in Statistical Retail Area 2013 as one area in 1952-53 has been divided into two areas for the 1956-57 Bulletin, called the Shire of Dandenong and the Shire of Springvale and Noble Park.
- (d) In the 1956-57 Retail Census separate particulars were tabulated for those parts of the Shires of Bellarine, Corio and South Barwon which for Population Census purposes are included in the Geelong Urban Area. These particulars are shown in Statistical Retail Area 2101A. For the purpose of comparison with the 1952-53 figures for these shires shown in Statistical Retail Area 2101, the 1956-57 particulars for the two parts of each of these shires shown in Statistical Retail Areas 2101 and 2101A should be added. Particulars for the Geelong Urban Area for 1956-57 can be obtained by adding totals shown for Statistical Retail Areas 2101A and 2102. Comparable figures for the Geelong Urban Area for 1952-53 are not available.

In the map for the State of Victoria, referred to above the combined area 2101 and 2101A has been numbered 2101. However, Statistical Retail Area 2101A can be identified on the map as the portion of the Geelong Urban Area which is not included in Statistical Retail Area 2102.

(e) The Borough of Moe has been created as a separate Local Government Area in Statistical Retail Area 2803. In 1952-53 this area was included with the Shire of Narracan.

Boundary changes have occurred in some other areas also but these changes are unlikely to have a significant effect on comparisons of 1952-53 and 1956-57 Retail Census figures.

Where sales of goods are made on commission, the basis of the collection is for such sales to be included in the principal's return and not that of the agent. The most significant effect of this is that sales of new motor vehicles made on a commission basis through country agents will generally be shown in statistics for the Metropolitan Area, where the businesses of the principals are usually located. (The 1956-57 Census form included specific instructions concerning commission sales of new motor vehicles. No such instruction was included in the 1952-53 Census form, but attempts were made to obtain the particulars on a basis similar to that of 1956-57).

Table IV.

This table shows for 1956-57 the number of retail establishments which recorded sales in the commodity groups specified, and the value of these sales, for each Statistical Retail Area. Estimates of population at 30th June, 1957 are also shown for Statistical Retail Areas in this Table. As mentioned in the Notes on Table III the City of Melbourne was sub-divided for purposes of the 1956-57 Retail Census into the Inner City Area and Remainder of City. These areas have been treated as separate Statistical Retail Areas - numbered respectively 2000 and 2001. The remainder of the Metropolitan Area, covering the suburbs of Melbourne, and the non-Metropolitan Area of the State have been sub-divided into Statistical Retail Areas which, in general, comprise groups of contiguous Local Government Areas. The Local Government Areas (or parts thereof) included in each Statistical Retail Area are shown in Table III.

Figures for Statistical Retail Areas in this table (and in Table V) are affected by commission sales in the same way as the Local Government Area figures in Table III (see notes on Table III).

Table V.

This table shows figures for 1952-53 (incorporating revisions since previous publication) which correspond to those shown for 1956-57 in Table IV. The sub-division of the City Area shown in Table IV is not available for 1952-53, and figures are therefore shown in Table V for the combined area 2000 and 2001 (this combined area was numbered 2001 in the 1952-53 Retail Census Bulletins).
