EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication is issued each month as a supplement to the annual *Catalogue of Publications, Australia* (1101.0) of the Australian Bureau of Statistics, which lists current ABS publications and gives brief descriptions (abstracts) of their contents. In addition, a *Publications Advice* (1105.0) is issued each Tuesday and Friday listing publications released on the day of issue and expected releases on the following five days (Canberra Office) or two days (State Offices).

2. Significant occurrences in ABS Publishing are highlighted in the section Publishing News which follows the list of publications issued during the month. Publishing News contains brief descriptions of the contents of new publications, describes changes in ABS publications and shows other information of interest to users of ABS publications.

Publication prices

3. Two prices are shown for each priced publication. The first price given is the 'over the counter' price while the second includes packaging and postage at ordinary rates within Australia. Overseas clients should add 10 per cent of the second price to meet the cost of overseas surface postage. Airmail rates are available on request.

4. Where no price is shown the publication is free.

Mailing list service

5. Clients who wish to receive free or priced publications on a regular basis may use the ABS computerised Publications Mailing List (PML) Service. Further details and order forms are available from any ABS office.

6. Clients (or subscribers) who already use the PML Service and who wish to amend their requirements should quote their account number when contacting ABS. The account number is shown at the top left hand corner of the address label used to despatch publications to clients.

7. Renewal notices are sent to all subscribers annually in respect of the subscription year commencing on 1 January. Payment for priced publications is required in advance and should accompany renewal notices returned to ABS.

Statistical information service

8. Each ABS office has an Information Service to assist clients. The service is designed to answer inquiries from clients on available official statistics, including statistics not published for economic reasons. Unpublished statistics cover a variety of topics such as population, dwellings, building, imports, exports, shipping, etc., in the form of computer printout, microfiche, magnetic tape or specially prepared tables.

9. In cases where a considerable volume of data has to be specially extracted or where a regular statistical service is required, a charge may be made.

ABS PUBLISHING NEWSNew Publications released during August 1985

1113.0 Information Paper : Integration of Economic Statistics : The Conceptual and Operational Framework, 1985

Irregular; first and latest issue 1985; 6pp

This paper describes the nature of integrated economic statistics produced by the ABS, the need for and development of such statistics, and the main features of the conceptual and operational framework for the production of such statistics, including the role of the Integrated Register of establishments, enterprises and other classes of transactor-type statistical units.

1231.0 Standards for Statistical Units in Australian Integrated Economic Statistics, 1985

Irregular; first and latest issue 1985; 134pp, \$3.60, \$4.80

This document specifies concepts, standard definitions and working rules for identifying and recording, on the ABS Integrated Register, of establishments, enterprises and other classes of transactor-type statistical units from or about which information is collected by the ABS in its integrated economic censuses and surveys.

5644.0 Lease Finance, Australia, January to April 1985

Monthly; first and latest issue January to April 1985; 12pp

This publication contains details on value of goods under new finance lease commitments (excluding leverage leases) classified by type of goods, type of lessor and by industry of lessee; new leverage lease commitments, classified by industry of lessee. Certain data are classified by State.

6347.0 Pay Periodicity of Gross Wages and Salaries, Australia, September Quarter 1984

Irregular; first and latest issue September 1984; 4pp

The publication contains the results of the Survey of Pay Periods conducted in respect of the September Quarter 1984. The survey produced estimates of the timing and frequency of pay periods and gross wages and salaries paid. These estimates are used for the adjustment of the gross wages, salaries and supplements component of the Australian national accounts to allow for variations in the number of pay periods in a quarter.

9216.0 Domestic Travel and Tourism Survey, Australia, 1983

Irregular; first and latest issue 1983; 55pp; \$1.10, \$1.90

This publication contains details on domestic travel involving overnight trips, nationally and at State and regional levels. Included are details on mode of travel, purpose of trip, as well as demographic characteristics of travellers, age, sex, etc.

4102.4 Accommodation for the Aged, South Australia, 1983

Irregular; first and latest issue 1983; 58pp; \$5.00, \$6.00

This publication is issued jointly by the South Australian Department of the Premier and Cabinet and the ABS. It is a comprehensive statistical report focussing on the accommodation characteristics of South Australians aged 65 years and over. The publication includes: a summary of recent government studies on accommodation for the aged, demographic profiles of the aged, their accommodation characteristics, and details of the funding and provision of accommodation and related services for the aged.

6220.6 Persons Not In The Labour Force (Including Persons Who Wanted to Work But Who Were Not Defined as Unemployed), Tasmania, September 1984
Twice-yearly; first and latest issue September 1984; 7pp

This publication shows labour force status of the population, persons not in the labour force by reason for not seeking work; reason for leaving last job, preferred work, whether work was sought in last 12 months, and time since last job.

Other Publishing News

. Balance of Payments, Australia, 1983-84 (5303.0), released on 26 September, comments that, effective from 12 December 1983, the government floated the Australian dollar and abolished a major part of existing exchange controls. Details of the effect of these changes on Australian balance of payment statistics are shown under the heading "Foreign Exchange Arrangements" on page VI of the Explanatory Notes of Cat. No. 5303.0.

. Exports by Commodity Divisions, Australia, July 1985 (5402.0) and Imports by Commodity Divisions, Australia, July 1985 (5405.0), issued in September 1985, announce that, from 1 July 1985, non-merchandise trade is no longer included in total (export and import) foreign trade statistics.

. Leasing Finance, Australia, January to April 1985 (5644.0), released on 18 September 1985, is the third of a new series of four publications designed to measure various lending activities and continues the implementation of recommendations resulting from a joint investigation by the ABS, Treasury and Reserve Bank aimed at the rationalisation of financial statistics. The fourth publication in the series, Commercial Finance, Australia (5643.0), is expected to be issued shortly.

. Average Weekly Earnings, States and Australia, June Quarter 1985 (6302.0), released on 12 September, indicated that the new series of average weekly earnings for the private and government sectors, for Australia, were included in this issue.

. Building Approvals, Australia, July 1985 (8731.0), released on 10 September, announced that, for the first time, smoothed seasonally adjusted estimates of building approvals have been included in this publication.
