4. MAINTENANCE.

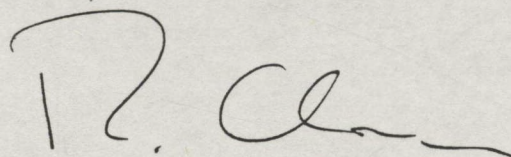
Water filters have been installed in the film processing rooms.
