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Additional tractor statistics available from this Bureau are as follows -

- (i) Number on rural holdings, classified according to State and type (annually) and age, horsepower, and fuel used (triennially).
- (ii) Production and assembly within Australia, classified according to type and horsepower (annually).
- (iii) Imports and exports, classified according to type, horsepower, and country of origin or destination (monthly).
- (iv) Registrations of new tractors, classified according to State (monthly).

NOTES AND DEFINITIONS

The tables shown in this statement have been derived from the quarterly collection of tractor statistics conducted jointly by the Department of Primary Industry and the Commonwealth Bureau of Census and Statistics. The information was collected from businesses which distribute the various makes of new tractors in each State.

For purposes of these statistics, a tractor is defined as a prime mover mounted on steel or pneumatic-tyred wheels, tracks or half-tracks, which is -

- (i) designed to draw agricultural implements or earth-moving equipment by means of a drawbar; and/or
- (ii) fitted with hydraulically controlled, power controlled or mechanically operated linkage to which agricultural or earth-moving equipment can be attached.

The horsepower classification shown in the tables herein is based on the observed maximum horsepower in all cases where official tests have been made (the results of the tests of the Australian Tractor Testing Committee are used wherever available). In cases where test results are not available, classification is based on the maximum horsepower as specified by the manufacturer pending an official test.

Tractors of less than 10 maximum horsepower (e.g., small garden tractors), road graders and fork-lift trucks are excluded from the figures shown. Also excluded are vehicles designed to carry loads (goods or passengers) whose ability to push or pull is incidental.

Receipts refer to the number of new tractors (Australian or imported) initially received into stock in Australia by businesses which distribute the various makes of new tractors. Small numbers of new tractors which are exported are deducted from receipts.

Sales refer to the number of new tractors delivered or in transit to final users in Australia as reported by these businesses.

Stocks refer to the number of new tractors held as stock within Australia by the same businesses at the end of each quarter. Stocks held by dealers or in transit to them are included. Tractors held in stock awaiting ancillary equipment before the sale can be completed are also included.
