

AUSTRALIAN PRODUCTION STATISTICS
PRODUCTION SUMMARY NO.47
AERATED AND CARBONATED WATERS, CORDIALS AND SYRUPS, AND
CONCENTRATED CORDIAL EXTRACT
JULY, 1966



The monthly totals of production of smaller establishments have been estimated from the returns of a representative sample. This sample is designed to provide reliable estimates of total production in each State. In addition, as the degree of estimation in metropolitan areas is negligible, figures for production of aerated waters in each metropolitan area are separately compiled and published herein.

It follows that any sample error for the States will be chiefly contained in that part of the State Total which is attributable to country production. Therefore the deduction of metropolitan figures from the totals will not always give reliable figures for country areas.
