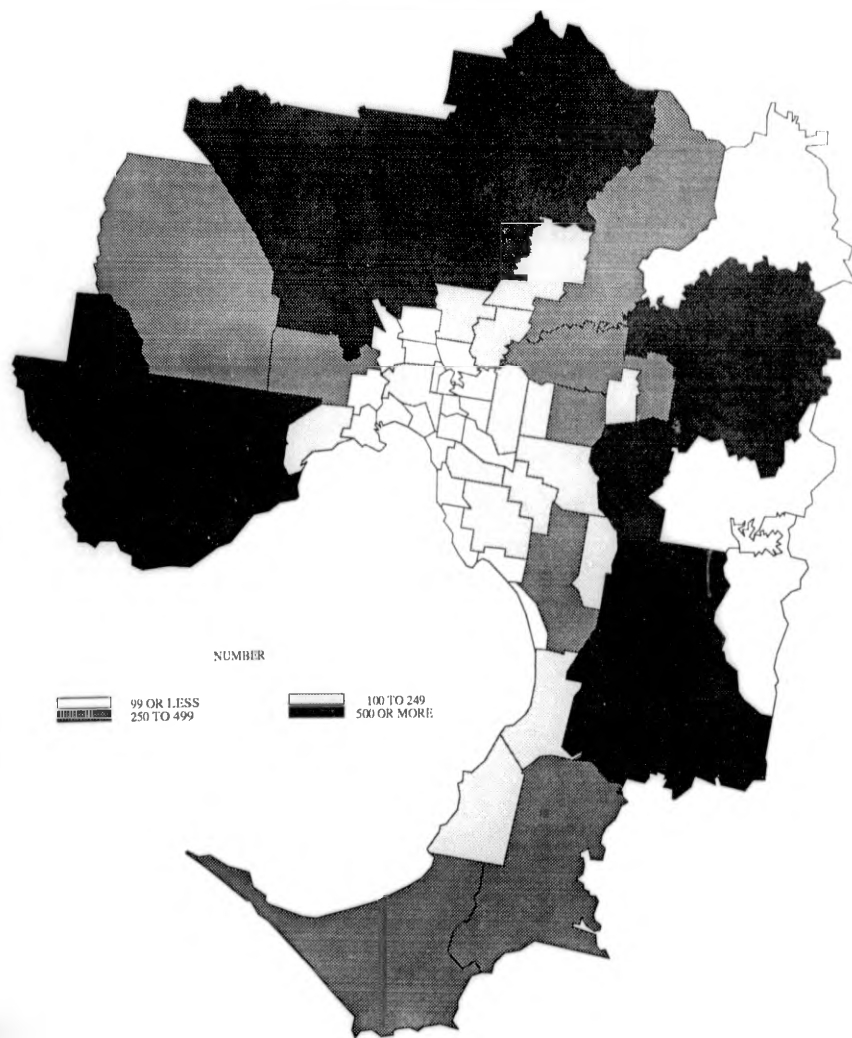

(\$ Million)

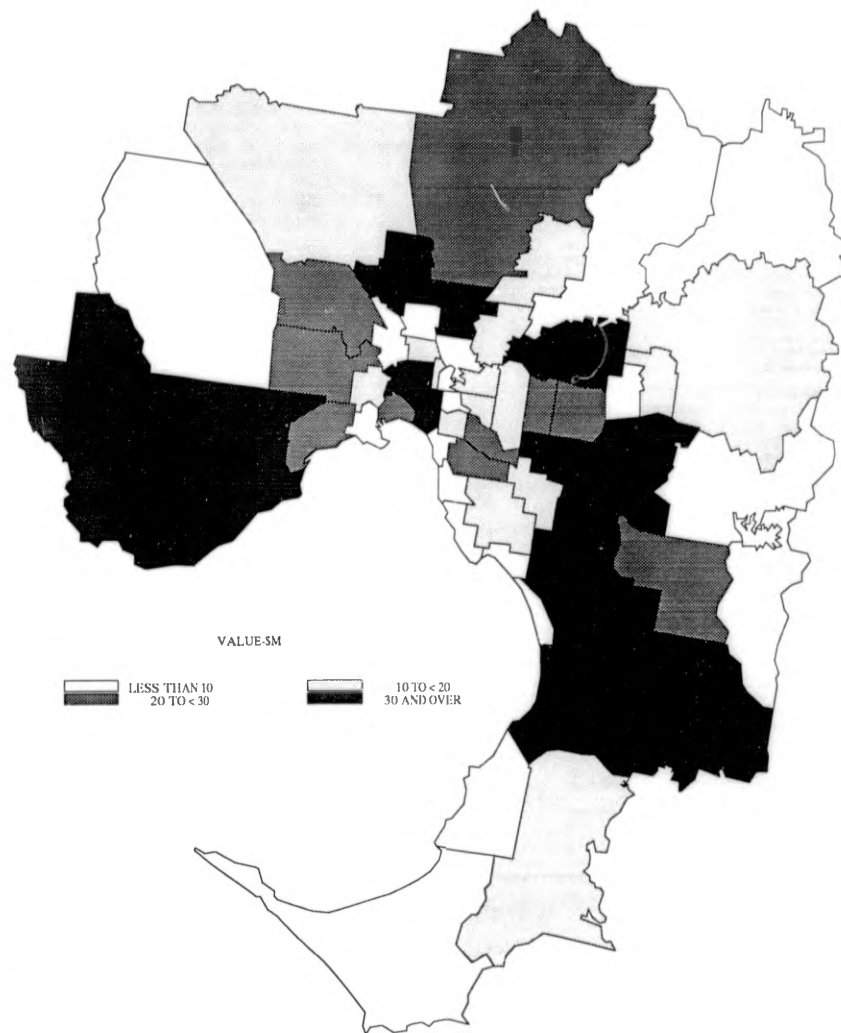
