EXPLANATORY NOTES

This publication replaces the publication 'Road Traffic Accidents Involving Casualties, Australia' (9403.0) which contained detailed national data on road traffic accidents involving casualties. Data relating to injury accidents prior to 1980 are not comparable with data in this publication because of a change in the definition of injury accidents. This change is discussed in detail in the following paragraphs. The last issue of 9403.0 was for the June quarter 1978.

Introduction

This publication contains statistics of road traffic accidents which were reported to the police or other relevant authority in each State and Territory of Australia during the quarters June 1980 to September 1981 and which meet the following conditions:

- (a) That the accident resulted in—
 - (i) the death of any person within a period of 30 days of the accident; or
 - (ii) personal injury to the extent that the injured person was admitted to hospital (particulars of injured persons who receive outpatient treatment at a hospital or who are detained in casualty for observation are excluded).
- (b) That the accident occurred on any road, street, railway level crossing or any place open to the public provided it is not outside the road reserve.
- (c) That the accident involved one or more road vehicles, which at the time of the accident were in motion, including motor cars, station wagons, utilities, panel vans, motor cycles, trucks, buses, trams and railway vehicles (when operating in the road reserve), pedal cycles (excluding tricycles normally used on footpaths) and ridden animals.

Background

2. Because of a lack of uniformity among States in the definition of data items and in reporting and recording procedures, the ABS suspended compilation and publication of detailed road traffic accident statistics at the national level from July 1978. In particular, the ABS was, and still is, concerned over the criteria used to define a *casualty*, a data item fundamental to the collection.

3. For national statistics purposes road traffic accidents were, in the past, defined as those which resulted in either the death of any person within 30 days of the accident or in bodily injury to any person to an extent requiring surgical or medical treatment. The fact that the term *medical treatment* is open to a wide variety of interpretations led to inconsistent reporting among the States and Territories and over time within the same State or Territory. As a result, there were wide variations between States in the figures shown for both casualty accidents and injuries relative to fatalities.

Recent developments

4. In an attempt to overcome this problem, and to satisfy the needs of important users, the ABS undertook to recommence compiling a limited range of detailed road traffic accident statistics at the national level from January 1980, provided that the definition of casualty accidents, for national statistics purposes, was changed to include only those accidents in which at least one person was killed or admitted to hospital. The ABS is aware that using *admitted to hospital* as the criterion for determining road traffic injuries has certain shortcomings. Whether a given condition results in admission to hospital can be affected by differences in treatment practices, the availability of hospital facilities and where the accident took place. However, evaluation of data based on the *admitted to hospital* concept indicates that they are of sufficient standard, at least in terms of comparability between States and Territories, to enable the series to be published.

5. A number of anomalies remain in the collection. In New South Wales for example the Motor Traffic Act does not require notification of accidents in which no motor vehicle was involved. However, some accidents involving only non-motorised vehicles, such as bicycles, are reported to the police and are recorded, provided they fulfil the other criteria. Similarly, in South Australia a road is defined as any thoroughfare open to the public by right or custom, including carriageway, reservation, traffic island, footpath, beach, carpark, etc. The statistics for that State therefore include accidents occurring in reservations, carparks, and on beaches which are normally excluded in other States and the Territories.

Scope

6. The scope of these statistics is as outlined in paragraph 1. They are compiled from accident reports which are prepared by the police or other relevant authorities in the various States and Territories.

Definitions

7. Most of the data items appearing in this publication are self-explanatory. The more important definitions are as follows:

Fatal accident: A road vehicle accident in which at least one person was killed or died within a period of 30 days as a result of the accident. Accidents in which both fatalities and injuries occur are classified as fatal accidents.

Injury accident: A non-fatal road vehicle accident in which at least one injured person was admitted to hospital.

Person killed: Death of any person within 30 days of the road vehicle accident where death is attributable to injuries sustained during the accident.

Person injured: Injury to any person involved in a road vehicle accident resulting in the injured person being admitted to hospital.
