Table 2 includes revised seasonally adjusted figures for whole milk produced. In the seasonal adjustment, account has been taken of both normal seasonal factors and "trading-day" effects. The revision of this seasonally adjusted series is the result of the annual re-analysis, details of which will be given in the forthcoming issue of "Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, 1971" (Reference No. 1.10) together with details of the methods used.

Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components in tables are due to rounding.
