

NET EXPENDITURE ON SOCIAL SERVICES.

1946-47 AND 1947-48.

The following statement shows particulars of the net expenditure (i.e. gross expenditure, less receipts for services rendered) on (1) Education, (2) Health, Hospitals and Charities, and (3) Law, Order, and Public Safety by each State during the years 1946-47 and 1947-48, including, in addition to Consolidated Revenue Fund expenditure, particulars of expenditure from Special Funds (Hospital and Charities Fund, Victoria; Hospital, Motherhood and Child Welfare Fund, Queensland; Lotteries Commission and Hospital Funds, Western Australia). It excludes particulars of (i) loan expenditure, (ii) expenditure on unemployment, bush fire, etc. relief, (iii) expenditure on aborigines and (iv) expenditure on various minor items which have been excluded because comparable figures cannot be obtained from the accounts of all States or because they do not come within the present classifications. Expenditure from Surplus revenue in Victoria has also been excluded.

Grand totals of gross expenditure for the classes of services represented are also shown.
