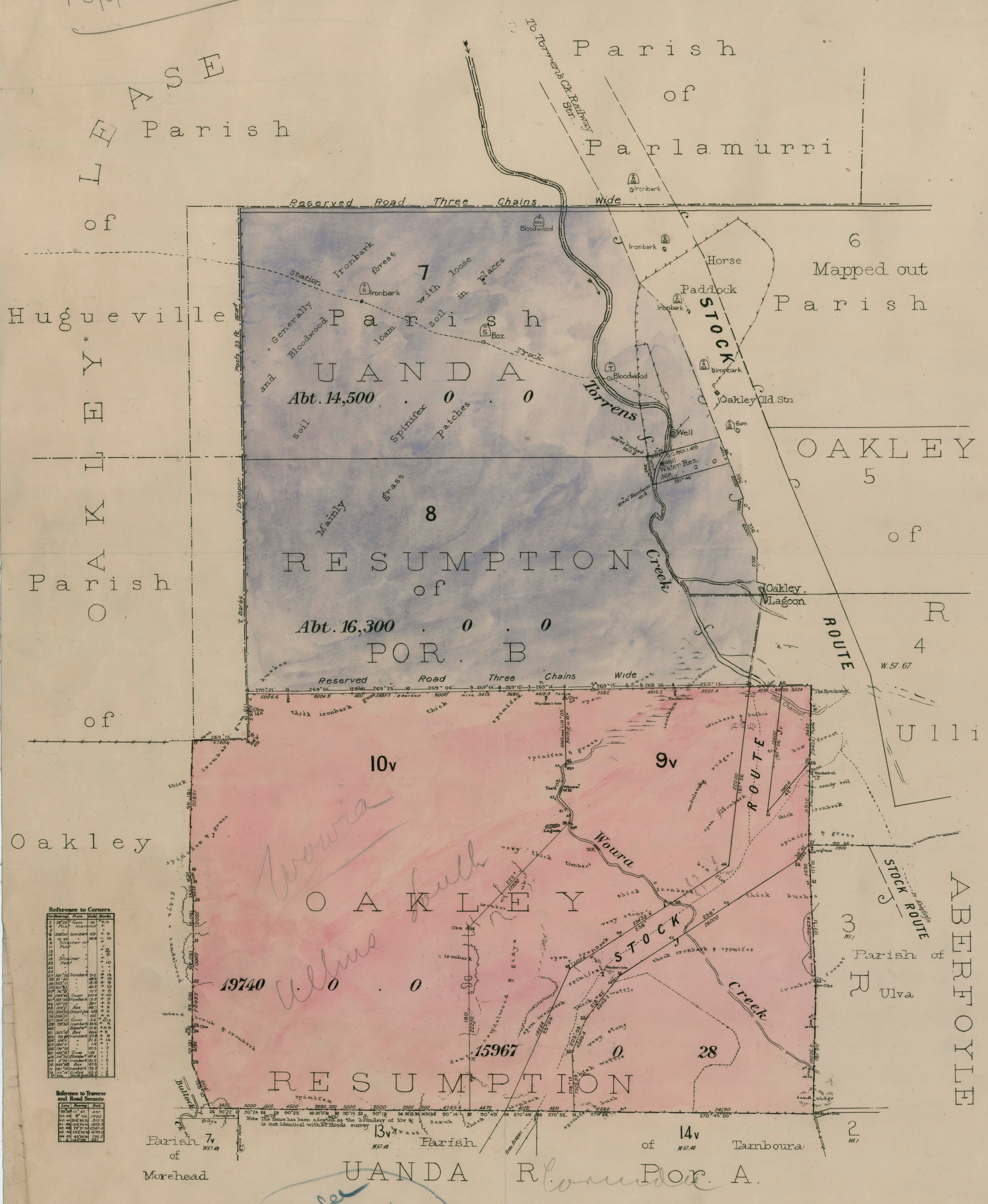

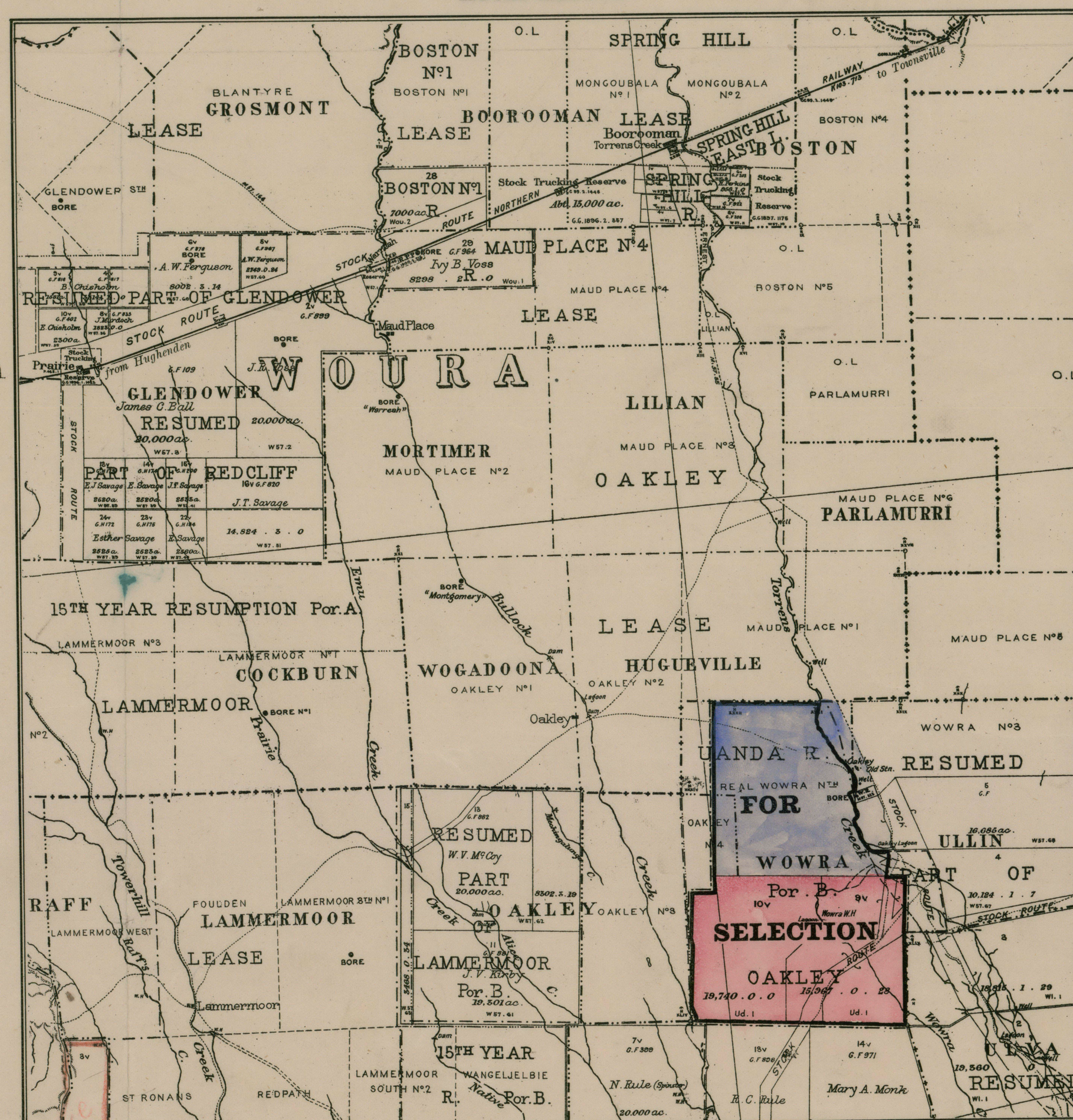

A PROCLAMATION
By His Excellency Major-General Sir HERBERT CHARLES CHERMSIDE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor of the State of Queensland and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by Orders in Council made on the first day of April, 1903, and the thirtieth day of March, 1904, I did, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, order that the operation of so much of the 77th section of "The Land Act, 1897," as requires land to be actually surveyed and marked on the ground before it is proclaimed open for selection should be suspended with respect to the Country Lands described in the Schedule hereto: And whereas, by the said Orders in Council, I did cause the said lands to be divided into portions and the position of such portions to be indicated on proper maps or plans: And whereas the said lands have accordingly been divided into the portions specified in the said Schedule, and the position thereof has been indicated on proper maps or plans: Now, therefore, in pursuance and execution of all powers and authorities in me vested under the provisions of "The Land Act, 1897," I, Sir HERBERT CHARLES CHERMSIDE, the Governor aforesaid, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do, by this my Proclamation, notify and declare that the said lands specified in the said Schedule, and situated in the undermentioned Land Agents' Districts, shall be open for Selection as GRAZING SELECTIONS, under the provisions of the said Act, on and after the dates stated in the said Schedule, at ELEVEN O'CLOCK a.m., at the Land Offices of the respective Land Agents' Districts, at the annual rent and for the term of lease specified against each lot respectively in the said Schedule: And I do hereby, by and with the advice aforesaid, declare that the maximum area which may be selected by any one person as a Grazing Selection or as Grazing Selections in the whole area to which this Proclamation has reference shall be 40,000 acres, and with regard to the respective sections of such area shall be as stated in the said Schedule.

And I do further notify that, in terms of the said Act, the value of any improvements on any of the said lots must be paid by the selector within twenty-one days after notice of such value as by law determined has been given to him.

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And I do further notify that, in terms of the said Act, the value of any improvements on any of the said lots must be paid by the selector within twenty-one days after notice of such value as by law determined has been given to him.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at Government House, Brisbane, this thirtieth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four, and in the fourth year of His Majesty's reign.

NOTES.—The portions delineated on this plan have not been actually surveyed and marked upon the ground, but are mapped out under the 78th section of "The Land Act, 1897." The areas are approximate only, and are exclusive of reservations for road purposes. The boundaries indicated may not be strictly adhered to, but may be varied, if necessary, in order to secure the most suitable positions for the various lines of roads, or as circumstances may render desirable.

Any person who wilfully and unlawfully, and with intent to defraud, removes or defaces any object or mark which has been lawfully erected or made as an indication of the boundary of any land is guilty of a misdemeanour, and is liable to imprisonment with hard labour for three years: Section 476 of "The Criminal Code."
