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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains statistics of the financial activities of Victorian municipalities for the year 1985-86 (i.e. the year ended 30 September 1986). Since 1979-80 these statistics have been collected using the standardised system of local government finance statistics for Australia, and the principles involved have been used in preparing the tables, e.g. financial transactions of municipalities have been classified to purpose groups, and significant trading activities transactions have been excluded from the tables dealing with ordinary services and appear separately in Tables 9 and 10.

2. The whole of Victoria, with the exception of the State Electricity Commission's Yallourn Works Area and other unincorporated areas, accounting for 49,370 hectares and a population of 70 (at 30 June 1985), is under the control of 210 municipalities which exercise powers and functions granted to them by statute, principally the Local Government Act.

3. The powers of councils include the levying of rates and the borrowing of money to enable them to carry out their functions. Chief among these are the provision and maintenance of roads and footpaths, street lighting, health, sanitary and garbage services, and recreational facilities. In addition, some councils have established business undertakings, the major of which are concerned with the reticulation of electrical power. Eleven municipalities, all in the Melbourne Statistical Division, supply electricity under bulk supply arrangements with the State Electricity Commission.

4. According to the ABS definitions of Public Sector Enterprise Units, legal entities which engage in both activities relevant to public trading enterprises and general government enterprises are split into separate enterprises where the legal entity is a local government authority with any of the following types of trading undertakings:

- (a) electricity undertakings;
- (b) gas undertakings;
- (c) abattoir undertakings;
- (d) bus transport undertakings;
- (e) water supply undertakings with a total annual current expenditure for all such undertakings greater than \$50,000 measured in 1977-78 prices;
- (f) sewerage undertakings with a total annual current expenditure for all such undertakings greater than \$50,000 measured in 1977-78 prices; and
- (g) any other trading undertaking with annual revenue greater than \$500,000 measured in 1977-78 prices;

5. Services provided by municipalities are partly financed by local taxes (rates) which are levied on the owners or occupiers of rateable property in each municipality. A municipality may rate on the net annual value or site value of a rateable property, or on a combination of both. Any change in the basis of rating may be subject to a poll of ratepayers. At 30 September 1986, one hundred and forty-nine municipalities were rating on net annual value, fifty-eight on site value, and three on a combination of net annual value and site value.

6. In this publication figures for statistical divisions have been included for most tables. Because of the impracticality of apportioning the finances of municipalities which lie partly within one statistical division and partly within another, the Shires of Cranbourne, Healesville, and Pakenham have been included in the Melbourne Statistical Division. Allocation of municipalities to statistical divisions is illustrated in Appendix B and highlighted on the map at the back of this publication.

7. The Shire of Werribee was declared a City on 20 March 1986 and is listed as Werribee (C) in this publication.

Reliability

8. Financial data collected for this publication are checked against the statement of accounts of each municipality. In some cases differences between local government accounting terminology and procedures on the one hand and economic or statistical requirements on the other may affect the comparability of the treatment of certain financial transactions. Overheads are not allocated on a standard basis in Victoria and for this reason functional expenditure data are not comparable between municipalities. For details of the concepts and special treatments required to generate standardised local government finance statistics refer to Standardised Local Government Finance Statistics, Australia (1212.0).

9. Local Government Finance Statistics for Victoria are collected jointly with the Victoria Grants Commission (VGC). The ABS acknowledges the assistance of the VGC in this collection.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS**ORDINARY SERVICES 1985-86****REVENUE**

Total revenue and loan receipts increased to \$1,880m for 1985-86, a 9.3 per cent increase over 1984-85 and a 23.2 per cent increase over the last 2 years.

Rates

Revenue increased to \$787m, a 9.9 per cent increase over 1984-85. Rate revenue accounted for 41.9 per cent of total revenue which has not varied significantly over the last 5 years. The total number of rateable properties has increased 2.0 per cent to 1,782,000.

Government Grants

Total receipts increased 6.8 per cent to \$361m. Government grants accounted for 19.2 per cent of total revenue, a proportion which has not varied significantly over the last 5 years. As in 1984-85 an increased proportion of grants came in the form of specific purpose current grants which totalled \$143m. Capital and current specific grants have increased by 5.1 per cent to \$225m over 1984-85.

Loan Receipts

Total receipts decreased 16.2 per cent to \$124m, which is 25.2 per cent above 1983-84. Loan receipts accounted for 6.6 per cent of total revenue as compared with 8.6 per cent of 1984-85 revenue, and 6.5 per cent of 1983-84 revenue.

OUTLAY

Total outlay increased 10.2 per cent to \$1,884m, a 23.0 per cent increase over the last 2 years.

Economic Services

Expenditure increased 6.0 per cent to \$578m, of which \$412m was expended on Roads, streets and bridges. Economic services is the largest area of expenditure and accounted for 30.7 per cent of total outlay. An increase of 18.0 per cent has occurred over the last two years.

Social Services

This sector includes Law, order and public safety, Education, Health, Welfare, Housing, and Community amenities. Expenditure in this area increased 10.7 per cent to \$424m, which was 22.4 per cent of total outlay. A considerable proportion of social service outlay (49.2 per cent) is spent on community amenities.

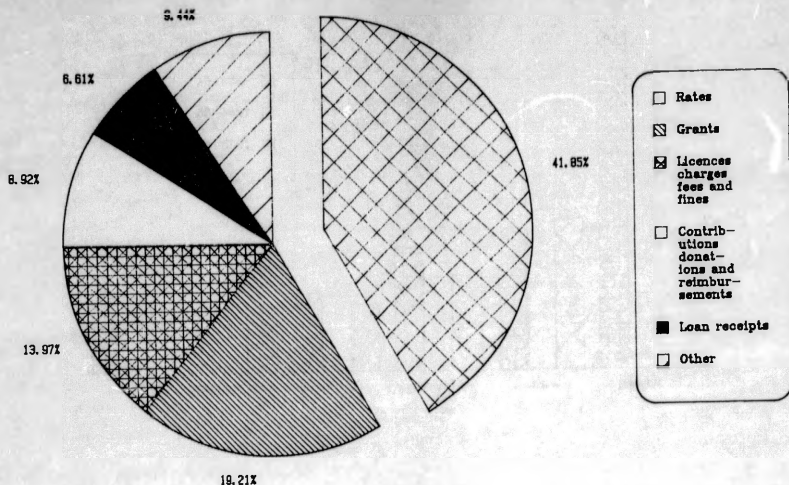
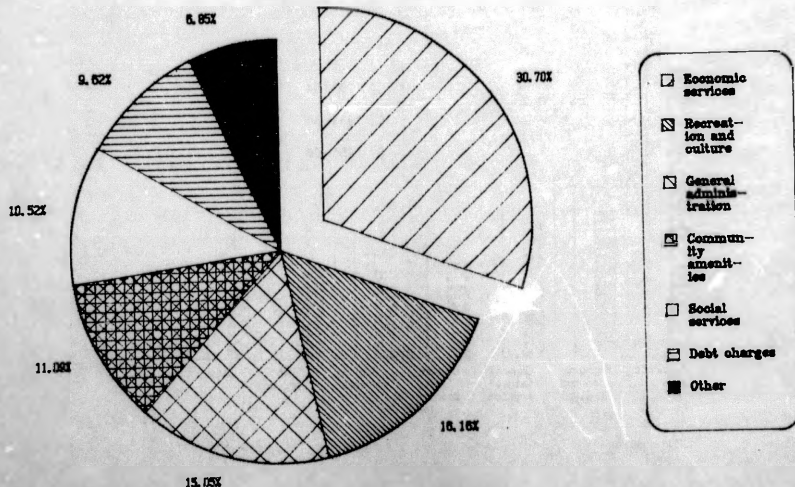
Recreation and Culture

Expenditure increased 14.7 per cent to \$304m which comprised 16.2 per cent of total outlay.

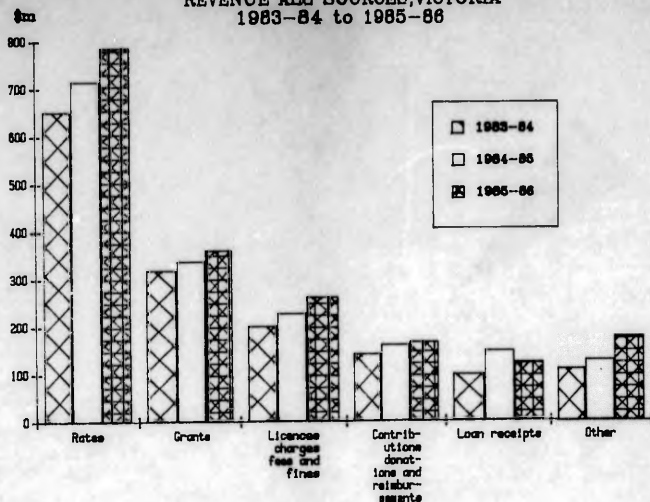
General Administration

Expenditure increased 11.8 per cent to \$284m, which constituted 15.0 per cent of total outlay. As a proportion of total outlay, expenditure has not significantly changed within the last three years.

OUTLAY ALL SOURCES, VICTORIA 1983-84 to 1985-86

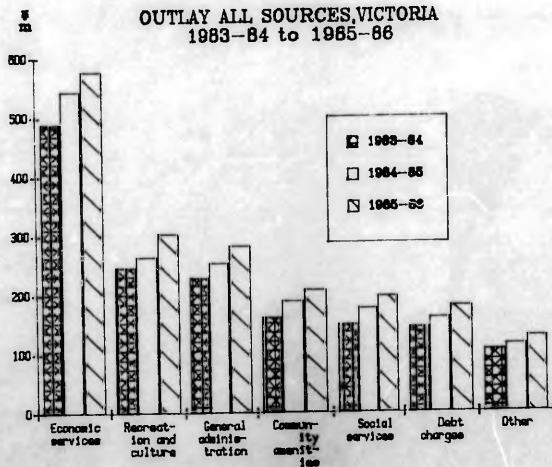

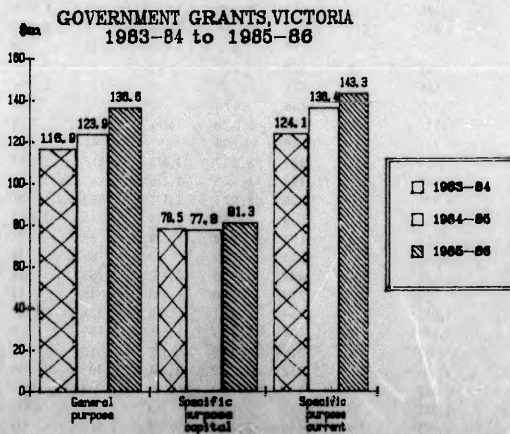

LENGTH OF ROADS, VICTORIA 1985-86

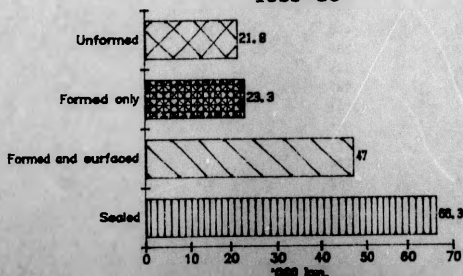

APPENDIX A : PURPOSE OF ACTIVITY CLASSIFICATION

The purpose of Activity Classification described below was derived from a standard international system presented in the United Nations publication *Classification of the Function of Government*. The numbers in brackets represents the Government Purpose Classification (GPC) for local government finance statistics.

GENERAL PUBLIC SERVICES

General Public Services (01) includes only those expenses relating to council members, executive staff, and general office (including council chamber expenses) i.e. 'head office' type expenses only, including government superannuation benefits. The amounts shown are net of recoveries from separate trading activities and outside bodies. See also 'Other Purposes NEC' below.

PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY

Fire Protection (02) includes contributions to volunteer fire brigades, payments to fire brigade boards, roadside cleaning operations (slashing, clearing, mowing verges, burning), and other fire prevention costs.

Animal Control (03) includes dog registration, pounds, straying cattle, and veterinary costs.

Other Public Order and Safety (04) includes beach inspectors, life-saving and beach patrols, and contributions to State emergency services for rescue operations during emergencies.

EDUCATION

Preschools (05) includes kindergartens, play centres, and other centres having qualified teachers.

Other Education (06) relates to the operation of school bus services, student hostels, the provision of scholarships, etc.

HEALTH

Infants and Mothers (07) relates to the operation of baby health centres and the provision of mothercraft nursing services.

Preventive Services (08) includes health inspection and administration, immunisation and X-ray programmes, school dental and health schemes, and the eradication of noxious insects and vermin such as mosquitoes, flies, and rodents.

Other Health (09) includes ambulance services, hospitals, and home nursing.

WELFARE

Families and Children (10) relates to creches, child minding centres and other play centres,

and services provided to families such as emergency home help.

Aged and Disabled (11) includes senior citizens' centres, meals-on-wheels, and other services provided specifically for the aged or disabled, and includes outlays on residential institutions for the aged or disabled.

Other Welfare (12) includes women's refuge (crisis) centres, drop-in centres for the unemployed or youth, services to migrants, social workers' salaries, and overheads. Housing for Aborigines is included under Housing (13).

HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AMENITIES

Housing (13) relates to the provision of housing for rental or use by employees and houses for sale to the public. Includes housing for aged persons and Aborigines but excludes residential institutions.

Sanitation - Household Garbage (14) relates specifically to the provision of household garbage services and includes the operation of rubbish tips.

Sanitation - Other (15) includes trade waste disposal, cleaning of streets, gutters, foreshores and recreation areas, special rubbish clean-ups, and anti-litter enforcement.

Sewerage services (16) includes all methods of human waste disposal such as deep mains town systems, effluent drainage schemes, septic tank cleaning and inspection, and nightsoil disposal ('sanitary' service). Transactions relating to the first of these methods are shown as Trading Activities in the output data statements, (10, 11) and the remainder as ordinary services.

Urban Stormwater Drainage (17) includes the lining or barrelling of creeks and the provision of open or deep drainage systems. Drainage associated with roadworks, flood mitigation, and agricultural drainage are excluded.

Other Protection of the Environment (18) includes flood mitigation works (such as the construction and maintenance of levee banks, dredging of rivers and diversion channels), beach restoration and foreshore protection, and the removal of dead animals and derelict or abandoned vehicles.

Street Lighting (28) mainly comprises payments to an electricity authority for the maintenance of equipment and supply of current to street lights.

Community and Regional Development (19) includes town planning, subdivisions, land clearing and reclamation, and urban and rural renewal programmes.

Other Community Amenities (20) includes women's rest centres, public conveniences, drinking fountains, cemeteries, street furniture, bus shelter sheds, and public clocks.

RECREATION AND CULTURE

Public Halls, Civic Centres (21) includes those multi-purpose halls used for public functions such as town or shire halls or community centres but excludes indoor sporting complexes.

Swimming Pools and Beaches (22) relates to the operation of swimming pools (both indoor and outdoor) and other recreational swimming areas on rivers and beaches including the provision of dressing sheds and diving platforms. Excludes life-saving, beach patrols, and beach inspection.

Other Recreation and Sport (23) includes all indoor and outdoor sporting facilities such as football and cricket grounds, tennis courts and golf links, and other recreational areas such as parks, gardens, playgrounds, barbecue areas, and walking and cycling paths.

Libraries (24) includes regional and local lending and reference libraries open to the public and the operation of bookmobiles. (The purchase of books, tapes and records is included as 'capital' together with new plant and equipment).

Other Culture (25) includes the operation and support of the performing arts, museums, art galleries, orchestras, the preservation of the national estate, and the presentation of festivals.

AGRICULTURE AND FORESTRY

Agriculture and Forestry (32) includes the destruction of noxious animals and weeds, contribution to pastoral protection boards, agriculture drainage, and forestry matters.

BUILDING CONTROL

Building Control (34) comprises salaries and expenses of staff engaged in the enforcement of building standards, including examination of building plans, and inspection of buildings and scaffoldings.

MINING AND MANUFACTURING

Mining and Manufacturing (40) includes administration, regulation, inspection, etc. of activities relating to mining and manufacturing. Includes the operation of quarries, pits, and hot mix operations.

TRANSPORT

Construction and Maintenance of Roads and Bridges (26) also includes works and services associated with roads and bridges other than street lighting which is shown separately (28).

For statistical purposes within the context of the output data statements, construction is treated as capital outlay and maintenance as current outlay.

Parking (29) transactions cover a wide range of activities including both on and off-street facilities. To achieve comparability, all transactions related to parking have been classified as 'Ordinary Services', including those parking stations recorded as a trading activity in the accounts of some local authorities.

Road Plant Purchases etc. (27), includes purchases of plant intended to be used mainly on roadworks, road safety, bus operations (not school), and other road transport matters.

Aerodromes (03) relates to the operation of airport facilities.

Other Transport (31) includes wharves, jetties, docking slips, ferries and marinas, and boat harbours and ramps.

OTHER ECONOMIC AFFAIRS

Tourism and Area Promotion (33) includes tourist bureaux, caravan parks and camping areas, and the advertising of the advantages of the area to attract tourists and development.

Salerooms and Markets (35) relates to council premises on which the sale of livestock, rural produce, and other goods is conducted.

Other Economic Affairs NEC (41) relates to economic services provided by councils which cannot be classified to a particular economic service category. Examples are activities relating to plant nurseries and storage. This item includes receipt of unemployment relief grants but not the corresponding expenditure. Prior to 1982 unemployment relief grants were included in 'Unclassified - other'.

NATURAL DISASTER RELIEF

Natural Disaster Relief (37) relates to assistance provided for victims of floods or bushfires. Rescue operations are included under Public Order and Safety. The reinstatement of capital assets is shown against the appropriate function.

OTHER PURPOSES NEC

Other Purposes NEC (42) relates to engineering and employment overheads and residual items such as the cost of works on private land, purchases of plant which cannot be allocated to specific purposes, purchases of land and buildings which cannot be allocated to specific purpose categories, the rent of premises other than houses (e.g. shops), work depots, and current deficit or surplus of plant hire operations (excluding depreciation). Prior to 1982 this classification included the receipt of unemployment relief grants which are now included in 'Other Economic Affairs'.
