

FRENCH LANGUAGE IIB 1995

The definitive arrangement on work and assessment

a reminder: the unit is worth 600 marks

stylistics & written : year's work 300 marks;
examination 100 marks

oral : year's work (three modules @ 50 marks each) 150 marks;
end-of-year examination 50 marks

the stylistics class

- i PB's exercises will count directly for 125 marks out of the 150 marks allotted to the year's work in stylistics (i.e. 5 exercises @ 25 marks each);
- ii in the last six weeks of the year, when stylistics will be taught by JG, there will be three fortnightly exercises (alternating with those for the written class); the best one of these three to count directly for assessment, i.e. the remaining 25 marks of the year's work;
- iii PB's class test will count for 25 of the 100 marks for the final exam;
- iv the other 75 marks for the exam will be divided 25 to stylistics & 50 to written.

the written class

- v from now on there will be six fortnightly exercises;
- vi the best three of those submitted will count directly for 75 of the 150 marks for the year's work (i.e. 3 exercises @ 25 marks each);
- vii the 150 marks for the year's exercises in the written class will be divided equally between the two semesters (i.e. 75 marks for each semester's work).
- viii the programme for submission of stylistics and written exercises will be as set out in JG's document of 20 July 1995.

This supersedes all previous arrangements on work and assessment.

The course co-ordinator of French Language Iib for second semester will be JG.

A suggested amendment to the earlier agreement on written work and assessment of it.

a reminder:

the year's work in stylistics & written counts for 300 marks;
the examination in stylistics & written counts for 100 marks

the stylistics class

- i PB's set work to count directly towards 100 marks out of the 150 marks allotted to the year's work in stylistics;
- ii in the last six weeks of the year, when stylistics will be taught by JG, three fortnightly exercises (alternating with those for the written class); the best two of these three to count for assessment, i.e. the remaining 50 marks towards the year's work in stylistics;
- iii PB's class test will count for 25 of the 100 marks for the final exam;
- iv the other 75 marks for the exam will be divided 25 to stylistics & 50 to written.

the written class

- v from now on there will be fortnightly exercises;
- vi the best 75% of work done will count towards the mark of 150 for the year's work;
- vii the 150 marks for the year's work in the written class will include a proportion for the work done in first semester.

This supersedes all previous arrangements on written work and assessment of it.
