Main Features

- During June 1985, 2,539 dwelling units (2,070 houses and 469 other dwelling units) were reported as commenced in Queensland. When compared with reported commencements for May 1985, these figures represent a marginal increase (0.8 per cent) for houses, an increase of 24.7 per cent for other dwelling units, and an increase of 4.5 per cent for total dwelling units.
- The local authority area with the highest level of dwelling activity was Brisbane City with 339 commencements, accounting for 13.4 per cent of the State total.
- For house commencements, the highest levels of activity, with percentages of the State total shown in brackets, were: Albert Shire, 264 (12.8 per cent); Brisbane City, 220 (10.6 per cent); and Logan City, 191 (9.2 per cent). The Gold Coast Statistical District reported 240 (11.6 per cent) house commencements while the Sunshine Coast Statistical District reported 104 (5.0 per cent).
- For other dwelling unit commencements, the highest levels of activity were: Brisbane City, 119 (25.4 per cent); Logan City, 85 (18.1 per cent); and Gold Coast City, 75 (16.0 per cent). The Gold Coast Statistical District reported 115 (24.5 per cent) other dwelling unit commencements, while there were 23 (4.9 per cent) for the Sunshine Coast Statistical District.
- For the quarter ended June 1985, house commencements totalled 5,993, 6.5 per cent more than those for the March quarter 1985 but 14.4 per cent less than in the June quarter 1984. Other dwelling unit commencements (1,439) increased by 11.4 per cent from those in the previous quarter and by 4.2 per cent from those in the corresponding quarter of 1984. Total dwelling unit commencements were 7,432, which was 7.4 per cent more than the March quarter 1985 figure but 11.4 per cent less than the June quarter 1984 figure.

Explanatory Notes

Introduction

This publication contains monthly details of the number of new dwelling units reported by approving authorities as having commenced in each local authority area with comparative data for earlier months. For the convenience of users, totals for June quarter 1985 are also shown.

Scope and Coverage

The statistics were compiled from monthly reports, provided by local and other government authorities, of commencements of new houses and new other dwellings for which:

- building permits were issued by local authorities in areas subject to building control by those authorities; or
- contracts were let or day labour work was authorised by Commonwealth, State, semi-government, and local authorities.

Major dwelling commencements in areas not subject to the normal administrative approval processes (e.g. mining leases) are also included.

The number of dwelling units created by alterations and additions to existing buildings, and through the construction of new "other buildings", i.e. buildings other than dwellings, is not included.

Comparability of Statistics

Because of the difference in data sources, collection methodologies, and timing of notification of commencements, care should be exercised in comparing quarterly data derived from monthly dwelling unit commencements statistics with the quarterly dwelling unit commencements statistics from the building activity survey.

Definitions

A dwelling unit is defined as a self-contained suite of rooms, including cooking and bathing facilities and intended for long-term residential use. Units (whether self-contained or not) within buildings offering institutional care, such as hospitals, or temporary accommodation such as motels, hostels, and holiday apartments, are not defined as dwelling units.

Explanatory Notes (continued)Definitions (continued)

A dwelling is defined as a building predominantly consisting of one or more dwelling units. Dwellings can be either "houses" or "other dwellings" as follows:

- (a) A "house" is defined as a detached building predominantly used for long-term residential purposes and consisting of only one dwelling unit. Thus detached "granny flats" and detached dwelling units (such as caretakers' residences) associated with "other buildings" are defined as houses for the purpose of these statistics.
- (b) An "other dwelling" is defined as a building which is predominantly used for long-term residential purposes and which contains (or has attached to it) more than one dwelling unit (e.g. townhouses, duplexes, apartment buildings, etc.).

Commencements. For the purposes of this statistical series, a dwelling is regarded as being commenced on the date when:

- (a) the building work is first inspected by a local authority or other government authority building inspector or surveyor, whether the work is passed or not. In general, the first inspection is undertaken at the foundations or footings stage of construction; or
- (b) the building work is determined as commenced by a building inspector or surveyor.

Ownership. The ownership of a building is classified as either "public sector" or "private sector" according to the sector of the intended owner of the completed building as evident at the time of approval. Dwellings being constructed by private sector builders under government housing authority schemes whereby the authority has contracted, or intends to contract, to purchase the dwellings on or before completion, are classified as public sector.

Statistical divisions. For statistical purposes local authority areas, as defined under the "Local Government Act 1936-1985", and comprising cities shown (C), towns (T), and shires, are grouped into statistical divisions.

The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan, and Redcliffe, the Shire of

Redland, and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, Moreton, and Pine Rivers. The City of Brisbane and parts of some adjoining shires are sub-divided into suburbs; separate figures are not shown in this publication but are available on request.

Statistical districts. To provide comparable statistics over a period of time, statistical districts have been defined around selected urban centres, with a population of 25,000 or more, experiencing urban growth beyond the local authority boundaries. These districts are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread over the next 20 years, and are shown in Table 1.
