

**COMMERCIAL FINANCE, AUSTRALIA
NOVEMBER 1990**

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MAIN FEATURES

Commercial finance commitments made by significant lenders in November 1990 totalled \$6,481.3 million, a decrease of \$903.9 million (12.2%) on October 1990 and a decrease of \$581.1 million (8.2%) on November 1989.

It should be noted, however, that November 1990 was a four week reporting period for some banks, whereas October 1990 and November 1989 were both five week reporting periods.

Commitments under fixed loan facilities were down \$184.4 million (6.4%) on November 1990 compared with October 1990. In terms of industry of borrower, there was a significant decrease of \$621.3 million (74.0%) in Finance, Investment and Insurance which more than offset relatively large increases in Mining of \$114.9 million, Manufacturing of \$138.3 million and Property and Business Services of \$116.9 million.

New and increased commitments under revolving credit facilities totalled \$3,791.3 million in November 1990, a decrease of \$719.5 million (16.0%) on October 1990. By industry of borrower, the major decreases occurred in Manufacturing, down \$487.8 million, and Property and Business Services, down \$249.4 million which contrasts with these industry borrowings under fixed loan facilities for November 1990. Retail Trade, which totalled \$245.8 million was at the lowest level since September 1989.

Total commercial finance commitments for the first five months of 1990-91 were \$34,925.0 million, a decrease of \$4,793.2 million (12.1%) on the same period in 1989-90.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication presents statistics of commercial finance commitments made by significant lenders to government, private and public enterprises, and non-profit organisations as well as to individuals (for investment and business purposes). Please note that lease finance commitments are excluded (refer *Lease Finance, Australia, 5644.0*). For detailed information on scope and coverage of these statistics and definitions of data items, refer to the January 1990 issue of this publication.

Statistical period

2. While the statistics are described as being for calendar months, it should be noted that:

- (i) in the case of some of the larger banks, the data relate to a month ending on the last Wednesday; and

- (ii) in the case of other lenders, some have accounting periods which do not correspond exactly to a calendar month and their figures are used without adjustment.

Unpublished data

3. More detailed classifications of the data in this publication may be made available on request. Generally a charge is made for providing this information. Revisions

4. Revisions to previously published statistics are included in issues of this publication as they occur.

Total credit limits at end of period

5. In principle, total credit limits at the end of period for revolving credit presented in Table 4 are derivable by adding new and increased lending commitments during the period less cancellations and reductions of credit limits during the period to the balance of credit limits at the end of the previous period. In practice, however, revisions and other adjustments such as the transfer of an existing fixed credit facility to a revolving credit facility will mean that such a derivation is inexact.
