EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains statistics of overseas arrivals in and departures from Australia during the quarter ended June 1977, together with statistics for earlier periods. Less detailed statistics are published each month in bulletin 3401.0.

Source of the statistics

2. Persons arriving in or departing from Australia are required to complete prescribed questionnaires in the form of Incoming and Outgoing Passenger Cards. These cards provide information to the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs for administrative purposes and serve as the source of statistics of overseas arrivals and departures. In accordance with the *Census and Statistics Act 1905-1973*, information relating to individuals, individual flights or ships and individual carriers which is contained in these cards or other documents is treated as confidential by the Bureau.

Scope

3. The statistics exclude operational air crew and ships' crew, transit passengers who pass through Australia but are not cleared for entry, and passengers on pleasure cruises commencing and finishing in Australia aboard ships not then engaged on regular voyages. Estimates of movement of transit sea passengers and cruise passengers are, however, included in Appendix A.

Seasonally adjusted series

4. Seasonally adjusted figures of total and short-term arrivals and departures are shown in Tables 5 and 14. Details of the methods employed in seasonally adjusting these series are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators 1977* (1308.0).

Comparability over time

5. New passenger cards and processing arrangements were introduced on 1 January 1974. This has affected slightly the comparability with statistics from earlier periods. The difference, as described in the earlier Bulletins (3402.0) (March Quarter 1974 to September Quarter 1976) and (3404.0) (1974 and 1975).

Category of traveller

6. Category of traveller is primarily determined by the passenger's selection of his or her own category on the passenger card. This selection is accepted provided it is consistent with other information on the card. Assisted settlers are identified as such by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, which also compiles statistics relating to assisted migration schemes and other matters within its administrative functions.

Permanent movement

Permanent movement consists of settlers arriving and Australian residents departing permanently, settlers being sub-divided into assisted and other settlers. Residents departing permanently are sub-divided into

former settlers, (persons who state on departure that they had come to Australia intending to settle), and other residents departing permanently.

Long-term movement

Long-term movement is defined as comprising visitors arriving and Australian residents departing temporarily with the intention to stay in Australia or abroad, respectively, for twelve months or more together with the departure of visitors and the return of Australian residents who had stayed in Australia or abroad, for twelve months or more (see also paragraph 7 below).

Short-term movement

Travellers whose intended or actual period of stay is less than twelve months are classified as short term (see also paragraph 7 below).

7. A significant number of travellers state exactly 12 months or one year as their intended period of stay. Many of them stay for less than that period and on their departure from, or return to, Australia are therefore classified as short-term. Accordingly in an attempt to maintain consistency between arrivals and departures travellers who report their actual or intended period of stay as being one year are randomly allocated to long-term or short-term in proportion to the number of returning travellers who report their actual length of stay as up to one month more or one month less than a year. A similar procedure is used for those travellers who fail to state their period of stay.

Country of embarkation or disembarkation

8. Country of embarkation or disembarkation refers to the country in which the traveller boards the actual flight or ship which brings him to Australia or alights from the actual flight or ship which takes him from Australia. Travellers may answer this incorrectly perhaps naming the country in which their journey commenced or will end notwithstanding any changes of flight or ship en route.

State of clearance

9. State of clearance refers to the State in which a passenger is cleared by Customs and Immigration authorities. Embarkation or disembarkation and clearance are often in the same State but not necessarily so.

State or country of residence

10. State of residence or country of residence refers to the State or country in which the traveller regards himself as living or as last having lived. State of intended residence is derived from the intended address given by settlers and Australian residents returning after a journey abroad. Particularly in the case of the former, this information does not necessarily relate to the State in which a traveller will eventually establish a permanent residence.

Country of birth, residence or citizenship

11. Statistics on these items have certain limitations. For instance, it is not possible to make a

distinction between Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland, nor to separately identify England, Scotland and Wales. Similarly "Korea" could refer to North or South Korea and "Germany" to the Federal Republic or to the Democratic Republic.

State of stay and country of stay for short-term travellers

12. Overseas visitors are asked on arrival for their intended address and on departure for the name of the State in which they spent most time. Australian residents travelling overseas are asked on departure for the name of the country in which they intend to spend most time, and on their return for the name of the country in which they spent most time.

Occupation

13. Statistics of the usual occupation of travellers are derived from the descriptions of occupations given by travellers. The descriptions given are necessarily brief and cannot be confirmed by reference to the industry in which they work or educational qualifications.

Estimation method

14. Overseas arrivals and departures statistics are derived from a combination of full enumeration and sampling, dependant on which strata travellers are classified to.

Fully enumerated strata -

- All passengers by sea
- All permanent movement
- All travellers with a duration of stay of more than one year or not stated.

Sampled strata -

All passengers by air with a duration of stay equal to or less than one year, sub-stratified as follows:

Overseas visitors, according to country of citizenship

	Sample
New Zealand or U.S.A.	1 in 30
U.K. or Australia	1 in 20
Canada or Japan	1 in 10
Other	1 in 4

Australian residents departing 1 in 10

Australian residents returning 1 in 20

15. Since statistics of the short-term movement are estimates based on a sample and subject to sampling errors, the estimates are likely to differ from those that would be obtained from a full enumeration. A measure of the difference which may be expected is given by the "standard error" of the estimate. There are approximately 2 chances in 3 that the difference will be less than 1 standard error, and 19 chances in 20 that it will be less than 2 standard errors. Some estimates have been combined because the large sampling errors on the

components would make them unreliable for most purposes. It is impracticable to publish estimates of standard errors for all figures in individual tables. However, tables of standard errors which give a rough indication of the magnitude of the standard error associated with any estimate of a particular size are given as Appendix B to this publication. Prior to 1974 a different sample design existed. Summary details of standard errors associated with these figures are available in earlier bulletins, (3402.0) (March quarter 1974 to September quarter 1976) and (3404.0) (1974 and 1975).

16. Although statistics of permanent and long-term movement are based on completely enumerated records, they are nevertheless partly estimated in that a small number of travellers are classified as short-term at the point of selection but are reclassified subsequently to the permanent or long-term movement in the course of editing. The statistics are subject therefore to very small sampling errors.

Corrections and imputations

17. The imprecision due to sampling errors should not be confused with errors due to imperfections in reporting, which may occur in any data collection, whether sampled or not. Every effort is made to minimise such errors, both through careful design of the passenger cards and through checks on the information once it is received. During the edit process some items are corrected where they conflict with other known information. Missing replies to certain items such as age, sex and country of birth are also imputed by reference to other related items.

18. Errors of this kind differ from discrepancies arising from the fact that certain information reflects the passengers' intentions at the time the cards were completed. These intentions are of course subject to change. The items particularly affected by such discrepancies are the distinction between permanent and temporary movement and in the latter case length of intended stay; country of intended stay; State of intended address; and reason for journey.

21. Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components of tables are due to rounding.

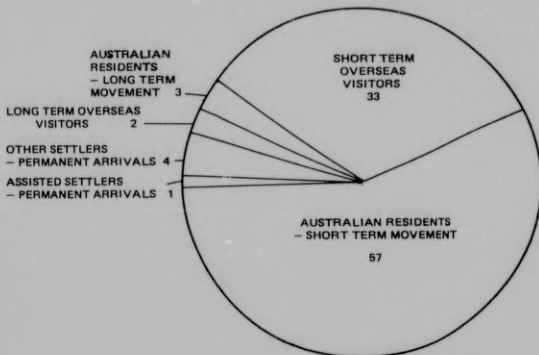

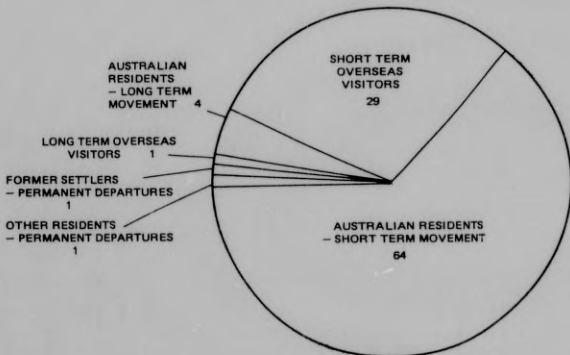

TOTAL ARRIVALS – 335,174

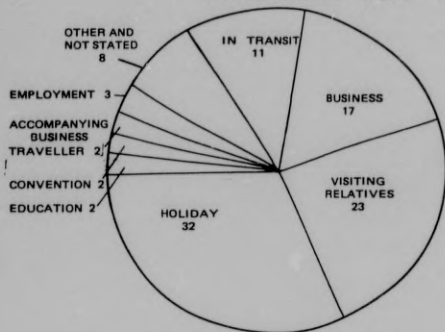


TOTAL DEPARTURES – 410,564

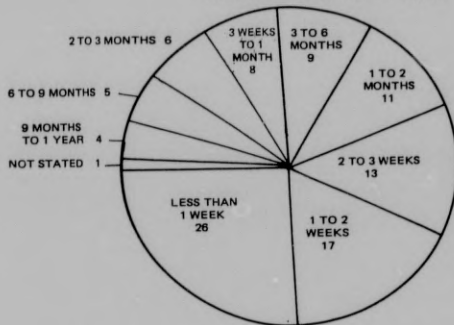


CHARACTERISTICS OF SHORT TERM PASSENGER MOVEMENTS
IN PERCENTAGES - JUNE QUARTER - 1977

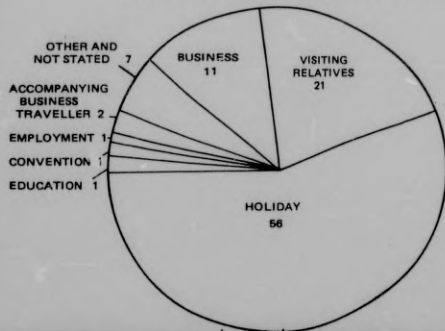
VISITORS ARRIVING - 109,579



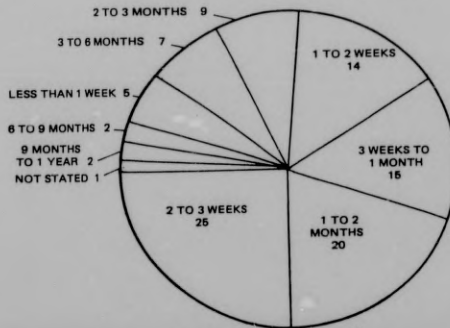
VISITORS DEPARTING -
