OVERSEAS ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES MARCH QUARTER 1973

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

This publication provides statistics of overseas arrivals and departures during the quarter ended March 1972. A section showing the following demographic characteristics, age, marital status and country of birth will appear in the June quarter issue of this bulletin.

2. Statistics of overseas movement are also published monthly, in less detail, in *Overseas Arrivals and Departures* (Reference No. 4.3).

3. The statistics of overseas arrivals and departures exclude air crew and ships crew; transit passengers who pass through Australia but are not cleared for entry, and passengers on pleasure cruises commencing and finishing in Australia on ships not then engaged in regular voyages. Summary information about transit and cruise passengers is included in the Appendix.

4. The statistics for December 1972 and thereafter are affected by two procedural changes and are not strictly comparable with statistics for previous periods. A transit area was established at Sydney airport at the beginning of December 1972 for overseas passengers intending to proceed overseas on another flight without leaving the airport. Previously, passengers changing flights passed through landing formalities and were included in statistics of short-term visitors. Many now use the transit area and are excluded from the statistics. In the March quarter 1973 the estimated number of such passengers was 5,070. Also, from 13 June 1972, the region within which ships' journeys may be treated as 'cruise' trips was extended from the south-west Pacific to ports adjoining the western Pacific and the eastern Indian Ocean; and the maximum length of such cruises was extended from 30 days to six weeks. 1,279 persons embarked on and 874 had returned from such extended cruises during the March quarter 1973; formerly they would have been included in statistics of the short-term movement of Australian residents. Passengers affected by these changes are included in the statistics of transit passengers through Australia by air and of passengers returning from pleasure cruises by sea.

5. The classification into permanent, long-term and short-term is based on information provided by the traveller on arrival in or departure from Australia. THESE STATEMENTS REPRESENT THE TRAVELLER'S INTENTION AT THE TIME. TRAVELLERS MAY SUBSEQUENTLY CHANGE THEIR INTENTIONS AND THIS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND IN INTERPRETING THE STATISTICS.

6. **Permanent movement** consists of persons arriving with the stated intention of settling permanently in Australia, and Australian residents departing with the stated intention of residing permanently abroad. **Settlers** are persons who, on arrival in Australia, indicated that they came intending to settle. **Former settlers** are persons who, on departure from Australia, stated that they had come to Australia intending to settle, had stayed for a period of twelve months or more, and were now departing permanently. Reliable statistics are not available of the number of settlers who left Australia within twelve months of arrival. Examination of passenger cards lodged in September 1971 and April 1972 suggests that approximately 6,000 persons per annum fall into this category of traveller.

7. **Long-term movement** (which is distinct from permanent movement) consists of the arrival of visitors and the departure of residents with the stated intention of staying (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more, and the departure of visitors and the return of Australian residents who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more.

8. **Short-term movement** consists of all other arrivals and departures, including those of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay.

9. Visitors arriving and residents departing, whether classified as long-term or short-term, are further classified according to their stated purpose of journey, the categories being: for visitors, 'in transit', 'business', 'holiday', 'education' and 'other purposes'; and for residents, 'business', 'holiday', 'education' and 'other purposes'. 'In transit' visitors include those cleared for landing who show 'in transit' as their stated purpose of journey to Australia provided that their intended length of stay in Australia does not exceed one month.

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10. Seasonally adjusted figures of total and short-term arrivals and departures appear in Tables 5 and 12. In the adjustments, account is taken of 'trading day' effects as well as normal seasonal factors. The influence of Easter, which may affect different months from year to year, is taken into account only in adjusting total arrivals. Details of the methods used and selected measures of variability were published in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, 1973* (Reference No. 1.10) to be issued shortly.

11. Statistics of overseas arrivals and departures are compiled from incoming and outgoing passenger cards, which are collected from all travellers under the *Migration Act 1958-1966* and which are supplied to the Bureau by the Department of Immigration for the purpose of compiling these statistics. Statistics of characteristics of short-term travellers from April 1971 to September 1972 are estimates derived from a fifty per cent sample of cards classified as short-term movement. From October 1972, the sample comprises one-third of such cards. Since cards are received from all passengers, and are processed in groups for each ship or aircraft, the total number of short-term travellers and their mode of transport is fully known. Statistics of the following characteristics of short-term travellers are affected by sampling: country of embarkation or disembarkation, country of residence, country of birth, nationality, state of embarkation or disembarkation, state of residence, age, sex, marital status, occupation, stated purpose of journey and actual or intended length of stay.

12. Statistics based on a sample may differ from those that would be obtained by complete processing. A measure of this difference is given by the standard error. These are about 2 chances in 3 that the difference will be less than 1 standard error, and 19 chances in 20 that it will be less than 2 standard errors. The standard error varies with the size of the estimate and the following table shows the standard errors of various estimate sizes, based on samples of 1 in 2 and 1 in 3 respectively.

13. Statistics of permanent and long-term movement are based on records of all travellers in this movement and therefore do not contain sampling errors. However, since short-term movement is a component of *total and net total* movement, statistics of characteristics of travellers in such movements are subject to sampling errors.

14. The imprecision due to sampling errors should not be confused with errors that might occur because of imperfections in reporting. Inaccuracies of this kind are referred to as non-sampling errors and can occur in any enumeration, whether a sample or not, and therefore will not be altered by the introduction of sampling techniques. Every effort is made to reduce such errors to a minimum through careful design of checking procedures and questions asked on the passenger cards.
