EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin covers banking and related statistics compiled from returns submitted under the *Banking Act 1959-1967* and from other information provided voluntarily by the banks including State banks.

2. Information from earlier periods in respect of the statistics covered in this bulletin is published in the annual bulletin *Banking and Currency* (Reference No. 5.1).

3. This bulletin contains seasonally adjusted figures for the major trading banks deposits, liquid assets and Commonwealth Government securities, loans, advances and bills discounted (see Table 8) and depositors' balances with savings banks (see Table 11). Details of methods used in seasonally adjusting these series are provided in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators* (Reference No. 1.10) and in Appendix A to the January 1973 issue of this bulletin.

Trading Banks

4. Trading banks comprise the major trading banks and several additional trading banks.

The major trading banks are:

5. Unless otherwise stated, the statistics presented are *averages of weekly returns*. The figures shown for liabilities and assets are the averages of liabilities and assets within Australia of the banks at the close of business on the weekly balance days during the period concerned. The weekly balance day is usually Wednesday. The figures shown for debits to customers' accounts are the average of debits for the weeks ending at the close of business on the weekly balance days during the period concerned. The figures shown for new and increased lending commitments are the averages of weekly commitments for the month ending on the second Wednesday of the month under review. Banks are exempted from furnishing a return in regard to selected liabilities and assets for the fourth Wednesday in December of each year, and for the fourth Wednesday in April 1973.

6. Liabilities and assets within Australia include liabilities and assets in Papua New Guinea and Other External Territories.

7. A classification of advances and deposits, overdraft limits and new and increased lending commitments of the major trading banks is made half-yearly at the second Wednesday in January and July.

9. Particulars for the Commonwealth Savings Bank, the three State banks and the Hobart Savings Bank relate to the end of the month, those for the Launceston Bank for Savings to the last Monday of the month and those for the private savings banks to the last Wednesday of the month. Particulars for the private savings banks for December 1972 relate to the third Wednesday of the month.

10. The number of operative accounts excludes school bank accounts and small inoperative accounts. The other sections of the tables relating to depositors' balances etc., relate to all accounts including school accounts and small inoperative accounts.

11. Depositors' balances in Australia exclude balances in Papua New Guinea and Other External Territories. Table 10 (Assets and Liabilities within Australia) includes assets and liabilities in Papua New Guinea and Other External Territories.

12. Deposits and withdrawals during each month include inter-branch transfers for those savings banks which operate in more than one State.

13. Details of liabilities and assets for individual trading banks, savings banks, the Commonwealth Development Bank, the Rural Credits Department of the Reserve Bank of Australia and the Australian Resources Development Bank Limited, are published each month in the "Australian Government Gazette".

14. This bulletin incorporates revisions made to figures published in previous bulletins in this series.

15. Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components in tables are due to rounding.
