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CENSUS OF THE COMMONWEALTH, 30th JUNE, 1954.NO.5 - SOUTH AUSTRALIA - POPULATION OF CORPORATE TOWNS, AND OF NON-MUNICIPAL TOWNS (1,000 OR MORE)

This Bulletin contains particulars of the population recorded in each Corporate Town, and also in each Non-municipal Town with a population of 1000 persons or more, in South Australia at the Census of 30th June, 1954.

These figures are issued at a comparatively early stage in an interim form, as they are derived from the initial Field Count, and may in some cases be subject to considerable amendment on completion of tabulation.

The Corporate Towns and Non-municipal Towns have been arranged in groups by Statistical Zones, then in alphabetical order. The population of Adelaide and Suburbs is shown according to the various Corporate Towns which it comprises.

Non-municipal Towns, as the name implies, are towns which are not separately incorporated for purposes of local government. They have been indicated herein by adding the letters "N.M." after the name of the town. Boundaries of these towns, were specially determined for Census purposes to embrace the urban areas which could be regarded as the town. Corporate Towns have been indicated by the letter "M".
