- * Two essays, in French, on set texts
(20 marks each: 15 for content, 5 for French) = 50%
length: 1500 words for 2nd year
2000 words for 3rd year
- * *Two exposer English (or in French)*
Three class papers, in French, on more
restricted topics: to be delivered *in English*
to the group, then submitted in *French*
written-up form to be marked = 20%
length: 250-300 words each
- * a 2-hour examination paper in November,
one question to be answered, in
French, on a text not essayed
during the year = 30%
