INTRODUCTION

How To Use This Publication

This booklet lists publications (printed or on floppy disk, magnetic tape, compact disk etc.), in numerical order, issued by the Queensland Office of the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) and those issued by the Canberra Office containing information relating solely to Queensland.

The list relates to the period from 1 January 1986 to 31 December 1989 and is to be read in conjunction with the list of publications issued for the month by the Queensland Office, given on page 2 of the *Monthly Summary of Statistics* (Catalogue No. 1304.3) and the list of new issues expected to be released during 1990 shown on pages 5 and 6 of this booklet. Although stocks of some publications shown in this list may be exhausted, copies are available for perusal in the ABS Library, the State Library, some municipal libraries and libraries of certain tertiary education institutions.

The booklet is divided into three sections – (A), (B) and (C). Section (A) relates to publications of the Queensland Office and Section (B) to Canberra Office publications relating to Queensland. The frequency, date of first, latest and next issue, number of pages, price and a brief synopsis of content are shown for each publication in both sections. Section (C) is a subject index in alphabetical order. This index is designed to assist users in determining which publications are relevant to various subjects. It is not intended as a comprehensive index of commodities or items covered in statistics. A list of titles grouped by broad subject matter is provided as a ready reference on pages 53 to 57.

The ABS Catalogue Numbering System

The system consists of a five-digit number allocated to each title. The first digit represents one of nine broad categories which cover all ABS publications. These, as they apply to Queensland publications, are listed on page 1, under *Contents*. The second digit represents one of nine subdivisions of the first digit and the third and fourth digits are permanent serial numbers allocated to specific publications within categories formed by the first two digits. The fifth digit relates to the Office of the ABS which issues the publication, e.g. 3 for Queensland.

Advance payment is required for all publications and should accompany the order form. Cheques should be made payable to the Collector of Public Moneys. Credit card facilities are available. Please note that refunds will not be made if an order is cancelled.

In addition to the publications which deal exclusively with this State, the Australian Statistician, Canberra, also produces many

publications which contain particulars for Queensland as a component of Australian totals. A complete list of all publications currently issued by the Canberra Office and the various ABS State Offices appears in the *Catalogue of Publications and Products* (Catalogue No. 1101.0) issued by the Australian Statistician. Copies of this catalogue are available, free of charge, from the Queensland Office.

Maps delineating the various areas by which the statistics are collected and published are also available and these may be purchased on application.

Suitable maps are included where necessary in those publications providing detailed statistics for small geographical areas. Also available are alphabetical lists of localities showing the legal local government area in which each locality is situated – the *Queensland Localities Index* (Catalogue No. 1102.3) – and alphabetical lists of streets in the Brisbane Statistical Division showing the statistical local area (suburb) to which each street has been allocated in the preparation of ABS publications – the *Brisbane Statistical Division Street Index* (Catalogue No. 1105.3).

Additional Services Provided

The reader's attention is drawn to the information consultancy service provided by this Office. In addition to published statistics, unpublished information is available on request for certain subjects. In cases where information has to be specially extracted, or where a regular statistical advice is required, a charge will be made.
