

COLLEGES OF ADVANCED EDUCATION 1971
(PRELIMINARY)

Reference No. 13.13

This statement contains summary statistics for 1971 of colleges of advanced education. These are institutions listed in the appropriate States Grants (Advanced Education) Act as colleges of advanced education, together with the Canberra College of Advanced Education. More detailed statistics will be published in due course.

2. The scope and definitions of statistics in this statement are, with one exception, identical with those relating to 1970 statistics, which are shown in the explanatory notes to "Colleges of Advanced Education 1970" (Reference No. 13.10) which was published on 9 November 1971. For this statement, where courses are offered on a semester basis student enrolments relate only to enrolments in the first semester.

3. In 1971 no student was enrolled in more than one course within the scope of this collection; the number of enrolments shown in Table 2 is thus also the number of students.
