EXPLANATORY NOTES

The following notes should be read carefully before any attempt is made to supply the required information.

General

This questionnaire refers to operations of all buses in your fleet during the twelve months ended 30 June 1971 in all States and Territories of Australia.

For the purpose of this survey a bus is defined as a motor vehicle equipped so as to seat seven passengers or more whether for conveying passengers for hire and reward, or for use in trade or business, or for private travel.

Section A - Number of Buses Registered

This question refers to the number of buses registered as at 30 June 1971.

Section C (part (b)) - Area of Travel

Include all miles travelled within Canberra and the A.C.T. with miles travelled within other areas of New South Wales.

Journeys between two capital cities (excluding Canberra) should be split according to the mileage travelled within capital cities concerned and the mileage travelled within other areas of the relevant State or Territory.

The geographical extent of capital cities is as shown below:

Sydney - This is defined as the Sydney Statistical Division and contains the area extending from the city of Sydney to the Hawkesbury River in the north, to the city of Penrith and the lower Blue Mountains (to Faulconbridge) in the west, to the city of Liverpool, the municipality of Camden and the city of Campbelltown in the south west, and to the Shire of Sutherland in the south.

Melbourne - This is defined as the area contained within a 50 mile radius from the Melbourne General Post Office but excluding the city of Geelong.

Brisbane - This is defined as the Brisbane Statistical Division and extends from Caboolture in the north to Beenleigh in the south, and west to include Ipswich and Pine Rivers (includes Redcliffe).

Adelaide - This is defined as the Adelaide Statistical Division and is roughly bordered by a line from Gawler in the north to Willunga in the south and extending into the Hills to a line through Bridgewater and Kangarilla.

Perth - This is defined as the Perth Statistical Division and is approximately the area between Yankeep in the north, Rockingham-Waikiki in the south and Wooroloo in the east.

Hobart - This is defined as the continuous area of urban development from Taroona in the south to Granton in the north including the cities of Hobart and Glenorchy and the eastern shore suburbs from Risdon Vale southwards to Tranmere.

Darwin - This area extends in the east to contain Micket Creek, Coonawarra East and Hudson Creek.

Section C (part (c)); Section D - Type of Service

"Route services" refers to travel where a stage bus picks up or deposits passengers who pay for transport over any part of the stage - haul.

(i) "In metropolitan and urban areas" refers to route services within the boundaries of the capital cities as defined above, or within the boundaries of settlements with a population of 1,000 or more.

(ii) "On intercapital routes" refers to route services between the capital cities of States and Territories (including to and from Canberra).

(Please note that the mileage shown for this question should be the total vehicle mileage between terminal points in the capital cities concerned, whereas in question (b) of this Section above you are requested to split this mileage according to actual areas of travel)

(iii) "In other areas" refers to any other route service which does not fall into the previous two categories.

"Country school bus services" refers to travel where a bus is engaged to carry school children, resident in a non-metropolitan or non-urban area, to or from school. This does not include carrying school children on a special excursion.

"Charter services" refers to travel where payment is made for the use of a bus irrespective of the number of passengers carried.

If the number of passengers carried on charter operations is unknown, please give the maximum number of passengers that could be legally carried on those charter operations.

"Tour services" refers to tourist travel arranged by the operator where passengers pay for separate tickets to the bus operator.

"Other services" refers to travel provided by a bus owner without charge to the passengers (including private use).
