WAGE AND SALARY EARNERS IN CIVILIAN EMPLOYMENT : AUSTRALIA, SEPTEMBER, 1961

This preliminary statement of Wage and Salary Earners in Civilian Employment for the month of September, 1961 will be followed by the usual Monthly Bulletin, which gives information in greater detail.

Monthly employment estimates shown in this statement are derived from the annual Census of Factories, monthly returns of Governmental Bodies, current monthly Pay-roll Tax returns and other direct collections. They relate to all civilian wage and salary earners except those engaged in rural industry and females in private domestic service. The figures are subject to revision.

Estimates for September, 1961 are affected by temporary stand-downs in the motor vehicle industry and by an industrial dispute in the mining industry.

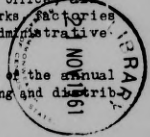
