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CENSUS OF ABORIGINES: 30th JUNE, 1939.

The Commonwealth Statistician (Dr. Roland Wilson) has made available the following particulars obtained from the Census of Australian Aborigines which was taken in all States of the Commonwealth on the 30th June, 1939.

With the assistance of the State Statisticians, the Protectors of Aborigines and the Police an annual Census of the aboriginal population of Australia has been taken since the year 1924. Certain particulars had been ascertained before that date in some States, but an annual Census had not been attempted.

In previous reports, reference has been made to the difficulties of collection, in consequence of which the figures published in the following tables should not be taken as more than reliable estimates.

FULL-BLOOD ABORIGINES.

The full-blood aboriginal population in Australia at the 30th June, 1939, was 51,557 persons of whom 28,746 or 55.8 per cent. were males and 22,811 or 44.2 per cent. were females. Adults numbered 40,482 and children 11,075.

The recorded numbers of the full-blood population remained fairly steady between 1921 and 1933 but in 1934 a complete check of most of the outlying districts of Western Australia and Northern Territory was responsible for a substantial revision of the figures for these areas and the total for Australia dropped from 60,101 persons in 1933 to 54,848 in 1934. From 1934 to 1938 the numbers declined during each year, but there was a small increase in 1939.

In 1921 the aboriginal population consisted of 32.3 per cent. full-bloods and 17.7 per cent. half castes. Since that year, owing to the steady decrease in the number of full-bloods and the rapid increase in the number of half castes, the proportion of full-bloods has fallen to 66.7 per cent. whilst that of the half-caste population has risen to 33.3 per cent.

At the 30th June, 1939, there were 11,343 full-blood aborigines in regular employment compared with 11,874 in 1938 and 10,925 in 1928. The principal industries in order of importance in which males are engaged are:- grazing, fishing, farming, domestic service, pearling, road construction and black tracking. The females are mainly engaged in domestic service.

HALF-CASTE ABORIGINES.

The half-caste aboriginal population of Australia at the 30th June, 1939 numbered 25,712 persons, an increase of 994 for the year. Of this total 13,545 or 52.7 per cent. were males and 12,167 or 47.3 per cent. were females. The number of half-caste aborigines in each State was as follows:- New South Wales, 10,069 or 39.1 per cent., Queensland 6,778 or 26.3 per cent., Western Australia 4,688 or 18.1 per cent., South Australia 2,197 or 8.6 per cent., Northern Territory 913 or 3.6 per cent., Victoria 719 or 2.8 per cent., Tasmania 273 or 1.1 per cent. and Australian Capital Territory 75 or 0.3 per cent.

Since 1901 the half-caste aborigines have more than trebled their numbers, having increased from 7,370 persons in that year to the present population of 25,712. The rate of growth has been consistently maintained, there being 10,113 in 1911, 12,630 in 1921 and 19,014 in 1931. Since 1901 the half-caste aborigines have been increasing at a consistently higher average annual rate than the white population.
