



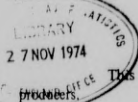

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**BROKERS AND DEALERS RECEIVALS OF TAXABLE WOOL
SEPTEMBER 1974**

This bulletin contains details of the amount of taxable wool received by brokers and dealers from wool brokers and dealers (private buyers) on the amount of wool received by them on which wool tax is liable to be paid.

To prevent possible duplication of the quantity of this wool, data are obtained monthly from wool selling brokers and dealers (private buyers) on the amount of wool received by them on which wool tax is liable to be paid.

Detailed statistics relating to sheep and lambs shorn, wool production, and average fleece weights are published in the following publications: *Wool Production and Utilisation* (Reference No. 10.38), *Sheep Numbers, Shearing and Wool Production, Forecast* (Reference No. 10.56) and *Wool Production and Shearing, Provisional Estimates* (Reference No. 10.69).

The information shown below is on the basis of the State in which the wool has actually been received and does not necessarily reflect the production of wool in that State.
