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PREFACE

This bulletin presents statistics of the financial transactions of local government authorities in summary form for 1984 and earlier years, and in respect of individual local authorities for the year 1984. This is the sixth issue of the bulletin in its revised format following the adoption by the Australian Bureau of Statistics of a standardised system of local government finance statistics. Accordingly, for most items of data, it is not possible to make comparisons between the bulletins issued for 1979 and subsequent years with earlier issues.

The data presented in this bulletin reflects only a summary of the more important items contained within the system of standardised local government finance statistics. More detailed information is available on request from the New South Wales Office of the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

MAIN FEATURES

Current revenue of all municipalities, shires and county councils in 1984 totalled \$4,452.7 million. Of this, ordinary services revenue totalled \$1,908.7 million, electricity supply revenue totalled \$2,269.9 million, and other trading funds revenue totalled \$274.2 million.

For local government ordinary services:

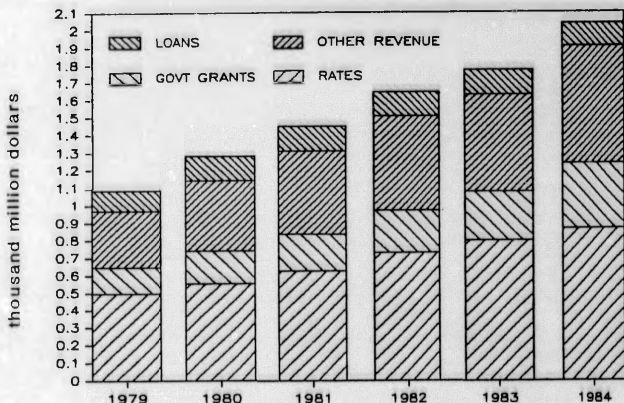
(a) total rates in respect of municipalities and shires in N.S.W. increased by 8.4 per cent from \$801.3 million in 1983 to \$868.5 million in 1984;

(b) expressed as a percentage of total

receipts, rates have fallen from 45.9 per cent in 1979 to 42.7 per cent in 1984, while other revenue and taxes, excluding rates and government grants, have increased in the same period from 29.5 per cent to 32.7 per cent;

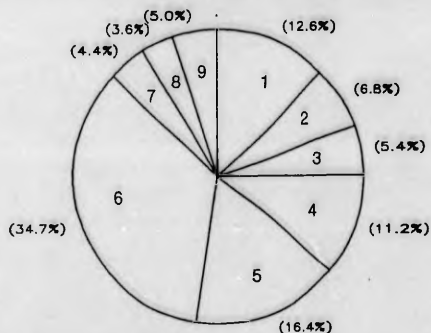
(c) total outlay from revenue and loans on goods, services and land in respect of municipalities and shires in N.S.W. increased by 13.1 per cent from \$1,544.3 million in 1983 to \$1,746.0 million in 1984. Of this amount in 1984, 34.7 per cent was allocated to construction and maintenance of roads and bridges.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. GENERAL

(a) The statistics in this bulletin have been prepared from local government authorities' annual statements of accounts. The accounts are kept in a prescribed form and relate to the year ended 31 December. The provisions of the Local Government Act, 1919 require councils to establish and prepare annual statements of accounts for each of the following funds -

- i. a general fund;
- ii. a special fund in respect of each special rate levied;
- iii. a local fund in respect of each local rate levied;
- iv. a trading fund in respect of each trading or business undertaking; and
- v. a trust fund.

Each of these funds is required to be separate and distinct.

(b) Those local authorities which establish special and local funds (other than for water supply or sewerage services) do so to carry out specific works and services to parts of their areas and accordingly levy additional rates to these parts which receive extra services or services of a special benefit. All services associated with these funds are services which could be financed from the general fund. For statistical purposes, services provided by the general, special, and local funds are defined as ORDINARY SERVICES.

(c) Trading funds are established by local authorities to perform the following functions: supply of electricity and gas, provision of abattoir and sewerage facilities, and supply of water.

2. CHANGES TO THE SOURCE OF DATA, AND COMPARABILITY OF PUBLISHED FIGURES

(a) Until 1 January 1979 the system of accounts used by local authorities was the result of the Committee of Expert Accountants appointed by the Minister for Local Government in May 1920. On 22 July

1977, the Minister for Local Government approved the establishment of another committee to report to the Minister whether existing practices and procedures were suitable and appropriate to modern local government needs, and if not what changes were necessary. Some of the major recommendations of the 1977 committee are as follows:

- i. the existing form of revenue account and balance sheet be retained for general, local, special, water supply and sewerage funds and commercial accounting procedures be adopted for electricity, gas and abattoir funds;
- ii. the income and expenditure system of accounting be retained;
- iii. National Accounting classifications be adopted; and
- iv. accounts continue to be kept on the historical cost basis.

(b) As a result of recommendations made by this committee, revised accounting schedules for councils' general and trust funds were introduced from 1 January 1979. Revised schedules for local, special, and the trading funds were subsequently introduced for the 1980 or 1981 accounting years. The main feature of these revised schedules was that they followed the broad level purpose classification of government outlays used by the Australian Bureau of Statistics to compile public authority finance statistics. Although a large number of individual accounts are directly comparable between the new and former schedules, many of the former accounts have been redefined and a large number of new accounts have been created. Some minor changes were made to the Purpose of Activity classification in 1982. Figures published in Tables 6, 7 and 17 are therefore on a slightly different basis to those published for years prior to 1982. While it is not possible to publish comprehensive comparable time series of outlays classified by purpose in Table 7, a limited range of data for some purpose classifications can be made available on request. Where further information is required regarding a particular comparison of current data to previous years, inquiries should be directed to the N.S.W. Office of the ABS (telephone Sydney (02)268 4181).

(c) In examining 1980 data a greater

degree of comparability between councils with respect to allocation of overhead costs than that which existed in respect of 1979 data was evident. Accordingly, this obviated the need to adopt the treatment (for overhead expenditure) used in compiling local government finance statistics from the 1979 statements of accounts, viz. 1979 overhead expenditure (where identified) was recorded as unclassified expenditure. Because of the different treatments relating to overhead expenditures between 1979 and subsequent years care should be taken when comparing summary data reported in tables 6 and 7 of the 1979 bulletin and later issues of the bulletin. Similar care should be taken in respect of the appropriate municipal and shire tables.

(d) From 1982 care should be taken when comparing N.S.W. Ordinary Services data to earlier years on expenditure for goods, services and land due to the effect of plant hire operations. From 1982 the net result of plant hire is included with current outlay on Unclassified Services. A surplus (profit) in the plant hire account has the effect of a reduction in this expenditure item. Note, depreciation is excluded from the plant hire expenditure and therefore has the effect of increasing the surplus by the amount of the depreciation (for 1984 plant hire depreciation for N.S.W. was \$30,367,000).

3. DEVELOPMENT OF STANDARDISED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE STATISTICS (SLGFS)

The ABS has developed a fully standardised and integrated system of local government finance statistics for Australia and data in this bulletin are consistent with the classifications and presentation of the SLGFS. After extensive consultation with major users, the ABS has prepared a standardised data set of statistics to be produced for individual authorities in all States and the Northern Territory. This will facilitate comparisons between local government areas within States and also between States.

A users' manual 'Standardised Local Government Finance Statistics' (Catalogue no. 1212.0) is available which provides information regarding the availability of the data, the definition of items used in

SLGFS, background information on the history and development of SLGFS, special treatments adopted for particular transactions of local authorities, and a detailed description of the purpose classification used in compiling SLGFS data. (Appendix A of this bulletin contains a description of the purpose classification.) SLGFS data for all local government areas in Australia, which are also aggregated at the State level are available, from the ABS on microfiche and on magnetic tape.

Within the SLGFS the items and dissections are grouped for convenience into sixteen statements and an outline of each statement is as follows:

- population at 30 June of the year of account;
- area;
- valuations, number of properties, year of valuation and ordinary services rates levied;
- ordinary services rates analysis;
- ordinary services revenue and loan receipts;
- ordinary services revenue - selected items classified by purpose;
- ordinary services outlay;
- ordinary services outlay on goods, services and land classified by purpose;
- ordinary services - outlay from untied revenue;
- trading activities - current transactions;
- trading activities - capital transactions;
- interest paid and received;
- analysis of long-term debt;
- financial investments and bank balances;
- roads; and
- plant hire - revenue and outlay.

4. STATISTICAL AREAS OF NEW SOUTH WALES

(a) For the purpose of presenting the principal series of official statistics for the State, New South Wales is divided into a number of geographical areas. These areas consist, for the most part, of aggregations of local government areas.

(b) The primary division of the State is into 12 Statistical Divisions. These are

Intended to represent regions of the State which are characterised by discernible social and/or economic links between the inhabitants and economic units within them, under the unifying influence of one or more major cities or towns. The boundaries of the Divisions have accordingly been delineated on the basic criterion that the degree of economic and/or social contact and interaction within each Division should be maximised. It should be emphasised that the boundaries of the Divisions cannot be regarded as sharp lines of demarcation - they may, of necessity, be positioned within peripheral zones in which the influence of two or more focal cities or towns overlap in varying degrees.

(c) In the case of Sydney and its periphery, the factors taken into account in drawing the divisional boundaries are necessarily different from those for the rest of the State. The Sydney Statistical Division is predominantly urban in character - and its boundary has been delineated to embrace the area expected to contain the urban development of Sydney (and associated smaller urban centres) for a period of at least twenty years.

(d) The Statistical Divisions are subdivided to provide a second tier of statistical areas comprising Statistical Districts and Statistical Subdivisions.

(e) Statistical Districts are areas which encompass an urban centre with a population of 25,000 or more and which are predominantly urban in character. They have been delineated using concepts and criteria similar to those for the Sydney Statistical Division.

(f) Statistical Subdivisions within Sydney Statistical Division were delineated in 1976, in order to provide statistical areas of optimum assistance to users (particularly physical and social planners). The boundaries of the seven subdivisions created within Sydney Statistical Division have been drawn to coincide with the regions formed by the former Department of Urban and Regional Development.

(g) Statistical Subdivisions outside Sydney Statistical Division are component areas within Statistical Divisions which have been delineated broadly on the basis of topographical and/or climatic features and reflect, inter alia, some degree of homogeneity of agricultural activity.

(h) Local government areas in more than one statistical area. Certain local government areas are divided between two or more statistical areas. However, the data contained in this bulletin are not available for these separate parts of local government areas and, therefore, data for the whole of each local government area have been included in one of the statistical areas between which it is divided. The areas involved are:

I. The City of Greater Cessnock, part of which is normally included in the Newcastle Statistical District and part in the Balance of Hunter Statistical Division.

II. The Shire of Inverell, part of which is normally included in the Balance of Northern Slopes Subdivision and part in the Northern Tablelands Subdivision.

III. The Shires of Blayney and Evans, part of which are normally included in the Bathurst-Orange Statistical District and part in the Balance of Central Tablelands Subdivision.

IV. The Shire of Cabonne, part of which is normally included in the Bathurst-Orange Statistical District, part in the Balance of Central Tablelands Subdivision and part in the Lachlan Subdivision.

5. CHANGES TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND STATISTICAL AREAS.

Details of name changes, amalgamations, and boundary changes of local government areas and statistical areas are given in Appendix B.

APPENDIX A : PURPOSE OF ACTIVITY CLASSIFICATION

1. The purpose of Activity Classification described below was derived from a standard International system presented in the United Nations publication "Classification of the Function of Government". The numbers in brackets represent The Government Purpose Classification (G.P.C.) for Local Government Finance Statistics.

GENERAL PUBLIC SERVICE

2. General Public Services (01) Includes only those expenses relating to council members, executive staff and general office (including council chamber expenses) - i.e. 'head office' type expenses only including government superannuation benefits. The amounts shown are net of recoveries from separate trading activities and outside bodies, see also Other Purposes NEC below.

PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY

3. Fire Protection (02) Includes contributions to volunteer fire brigades, payments to fire brigade boards, roadside clearing operations (slashing, clearing, mowing verges, burning) and other fire prevention costs.

4. Animal Control (03) Includes dog registration, pounds, straying cattle and veterinary costs.

5. Other Public Order and Safety (04) Includes beach inspectors, lifesaving and beach patrols, and contributions to State emergency services for rescue operations during emergencies.

EDUCATION

6. Preschools (05) Includes kindergartens and other centres having qualified teachers and are primarily educational institutions. Play centres are included under Welfare - Families and Children.

7. Other Education (06) relates to the operation of school bus services, student hostels, the provision of scholarships, etc.

HEALTH

8. Infants and Mothers (07) relates to the operation of baby health centres and the provision of mothercraft nursing services.

9. Preventive Services (08) Includes health inspection and administration, immunisation and x-ray programs, school dental and health schemes and the eradication of noxious insects and vermin such as mosquitoes, flies and rodents.

10. Other Health (09) Includes ambulance services, hospitals, and home nursing.

WELFARE

11. Families and Children (10) relates to creches, child minding centres and other play centres and services provided to families such as emergency home help.

12. Aged and Disabled (11) Includes senior citizens centres, meals-on-wheels and other services provided specifically for the aged or disabled. Includes outlays on residential institutions for aged or disabled.

13. Other Welfare (12) Includes womens refuge (crisis) centres, drop-in centres for the unemployed or youth, services to migrants, social workers salary and overheads. Housing for Aborigines is included under Housing (13).

HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AMENITIES

14. Housing (13) relates to the provision of housing for rental or use by employees and houses for sale to the public. Includes housing for aged persons and aborigines but excludes residential institutions.

15. Sanitation - Household Garbage (14) relates specifically to the provision of household garbage services and includes the operation of rubbish tips.

16. Sanitation - Other (15) Includes trade waste disposal, cleaning of streets, gutters, foreshores and recreation areas, special rubbish clean-ups, anti-litter enforcement.

17. Sewerage services (16) includes all methods of human waste disposal such as deep mains town systems, effluent drainage schemes, septic tank cleaning and inspection, nightsoil disposal ('sanitary' service). Transactions relating to the first of these methods are shown as Trading Activities in the output data statements,

(Nos. 10, 11) and the remainder as ordinary services.

18. Urban Stormwater Drainage (17) Includes the lining or barrelling of creeks and the provision of open or deep drainage systems. Drainage associated with roadworks, flood mitigation and agricultural drainage are excluded.

19. Other Protection of the Environment (18) Includes flood mitigation works (such as the construction and maintenance of levee banks, dredging of rivers and diversion channels), beach restoration and foreshore protection and the removal of dead animals and derelict or abandoned vehicles.

20. Street Lighting (28) mainly comprises payments to an electricity authority for the maintenance of equipment and supply of current to street lights.

21. Community and Regional Development (19) Includes town planning, subdivisions, land clearing and reclamation and urban and rural renewal programs.

22. Other Community Amenities (20) Includes women's rest centres, public conveniences, drinking fountains, cemeteries, street furniture, bus shelter sheds and public clocks.

RECREATION AND CULTURE

23. Public Halls, Civic Centres (21) Includes those multi-purpose halls used for public functions such as town or shire halls or community centres but excludes indoor sporting complexes.

24. Swimming Pools and Beaches (22) relates to the operation of swimming pools (both indoor and outdoor) and other recreational swimming areas on rivers and beaches including the provision of dressing sheds, diving platforms. Excludes life saving, beach patrols and beach inspection.

25. Other Recreation and Sport (23) Includes all indoor and outdoor sporting facilities such as football and cricket grounds, tennis courts and golf links and other recreational areas such as parks, gardens, playgrounds, barbeque areas and walking and cycling paths.

26. Libraries (24) Includes regional and local, lending and reference libraries open to the public and the operation of bookmobiles. (The purchase of books, tapes and records is included as 'capital' together with new plant and equipment.)

27. Other Culture (25) Includes the operation and support of the performing arts, museums, art galleries, orchestras, the preservation of the national estate and the presentation of festivals.

AGRICULTURE AND FORESTRY

28. Agriculture and Forestry (32) Includes the destruction of noxious animals and weeds contribution to pastoral protection boards, agriculture drainage and forestry matters.

BUILDING CONTROL

29. Building Control (34) comprises salaries and expenses of staff engaged in the enforcement of building standards including examination of building plans, and inspection of buildings and scaffoldings.

MINING AND MANUFACTURING

30. Mining and Manufacturing (40) Includes administration, regulation, inspection etc of activities relating to mining and manufacturing. Includes the operation of quarries, pits and hot mix operations.

TRANSPORT

31. Construction and Maintenance of Roads and Bridges (26). This item also includes works and services associated with roads and bridges other than street lighting which is shown separately (No. 28). For statistical purposes within the context of the output data statements, construction is treated as capital outlay and maintenance as current outlay.

32. Parking (29) transactions cover a wide range of activities including both on and off-street facilities. To achieve comparability, all transactions related to parking have been classified as Ordinary Services including those parking stations recorded as a trading activity in the accounts of some local authorities.

33. Road Plant Purchases etc (27) includes purchases of plant intended to be used mainly on roadworks, road safety, bus operations (not school) and other road transport matters.

34. Aerodromes (30) relates to the operation of airport facilities.

35. Other Transport (31) includes wharves, jetties, docking slips, ferries and marinas and boat harbours and ramps.

OTHER ECONOMIC AFFAIRS

36. Tourism and Area Promotion (33) includes tourist bureaus, caravan parks and camping areas and advertising the advantages of the area to attract tourists and development.

37. Saleyards and Markets (35) relates to council premises on which the sale of livestock, rural produce and other goods is conducted.

38. Other Economic Affairs NEC (41) relates to economic services provided by councils which cannot be classified to a particular economic service category. Examples are activities relating to plant nurseries, storage. Includes receipt of unemployment

relief grants but not the corresponding expenditure. Prior to 1982 unemployment relief grants were included in "Unclassified - other".

NATURAL DISASTER RELIEF

39. Natural Disaster Relief (37) relates to assistance provided for victims of floods or bush fires. Rescue operations are included under Public Order and Safety. The reinstatement of capital assets are shown against the appropriate function.

OTHER PURPOSES NEC

40. Other Purposes NEC (42) relates to engineering and employment overheads and residual items such as the cost of works on private land, purchases of plant which cannot be allocated to specific purposes, purchases of land and buildings which cannot be allocated to specific purpose categories, the rent of premises other than houses (e.g. shops) works depots, and current deficit or surplus of plant hire operations (excluding depreciation). Prior to 1982 this classification included the receipt of unemployment relief grants which are now included in Other Economic Affairs.
