DEMOGRAPHY: SMALL AREA SUMMARY, QUEENSLAND, 1986

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EXPLANATORY NOTESIntroduction

This publication provides a summary of the most recent estimated resident population, births, and deaths statistics available for small areas in Queensland. Statistics for earlier years are also included to enable recent trends to be examined.

Australian Standard Geographical Classification

2. Statistics on estimated resident population, births, and deaths are presented according to the publication 'Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) Edition 3' (Catalogue No. 1216.0) which contains details of the spatial units and coding structure.

3. Legal local government areas (LGAs), as defined under the 'Local Government Act 1936-1987', are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T), and shires (S).

4. Statistical local areas (SLAs) are the smallest types of spatial units in the ASGC for which population data are presented in this publication. They correspond either to legal local government areas (LGAs) or to suburbs in certain urban legal LGAs. Some legal LGAs are split into two or more parts, with each part forming a separate spatial unit. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

EXPLANATORY NOTES (continued)

5. Statistical subdivisions (SSDs) consist of one or more SLAs.

6. Statistical divisions, which consist of one or more SSDs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan, and Redcliffe, the Shire of Redland, and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, Moreton, and Pine Rivers.

7. Statistical districts have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the legal LGA boundaries.

Definitions

8. The estimated resident population at 30 June 1976, 1981, and 1986 has been calculated by adjusting usual residence Census counts for Census under-enumeration and adding the number of residents temporarily overseas at Census date.

9. For intercensal years, the estimated resident population is calculated by taking into account changes in a number of variables which indicate population growth. These are natural increase, pension and family allowance information, dwelling approvals and commencements, electoral enrolments, school enrolments, and Medicare registrations. A linear regression model is used to assist in making the estimates.

10. The statistics shown for births and deaths relate to usual residents of Queensland, regardless of where in Australia the event occurred. Births and fetal deaths have been allocated to the local government area in which the mother's usual residence was located and deaths have been allocated to the local government area in which the deceased's place of usual residence was located. It should be noted that prior to 1983, births and deaths statistics were compiled on a State of registration basis, hence births and deaths of Queensland residents which occurred interstate were excluded, but births and deaths of interstate visitors which occurred in Queensland were included.

11. The births and deaths statistics represent events registered during the calendar years shown. Because of delays in registration, some births and

deaths occurring in one year are not registered until the following year or even later.

12. Births. For statistics in this publication, the term birth relates, unless otherwise stated, to a live birth, which is the delivery of a child, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy, who after being born, breathes or shows any other evidence of life such as a heart-beat.

13. Nuptiality. Live births are identified as nuptial where the father registered was married to the mother at the time of the birth, or where the husband died during the pregnancy. Children of Aboriginal mothers considered to be tribally married are classified as nuptial. All other births are classified as ex-nuptial whether or not the parents were living together at the time of the birth and whether or not the child may subsequently have been legitimated or adopted.

14. Infant deaths represent the deaths of children aged less than 1 year.

15. A fetal death is defined as the delivery of a child, weighing at least 500 grams at delivery (or, when birthweight is unavailable, of at least 22 weeks gestation) who did not, at any time after delivery, breathe or show any other evidence of life such as a heart-beat.

Average Annual Rates of Population Growth

16. These rates are shown for the intercensal periods 30 June 1976 to 30 June 1981 and 30 June 1981 to 30 June 1986 in Tables 1 and 2. The rates have been calculated using the formula:

$$r = \sqrt[y]{\frac{P_e}{P_b}} - 1$$

where 'r' is a compound annual rate of growth throughout the period (expressed as a percentage in Tables 1 and 2), 'P_b' is the population at the beginning of the period, and 'P_e' is the population at the end of the period, and 'y' is the number of years covered by the period. For example,

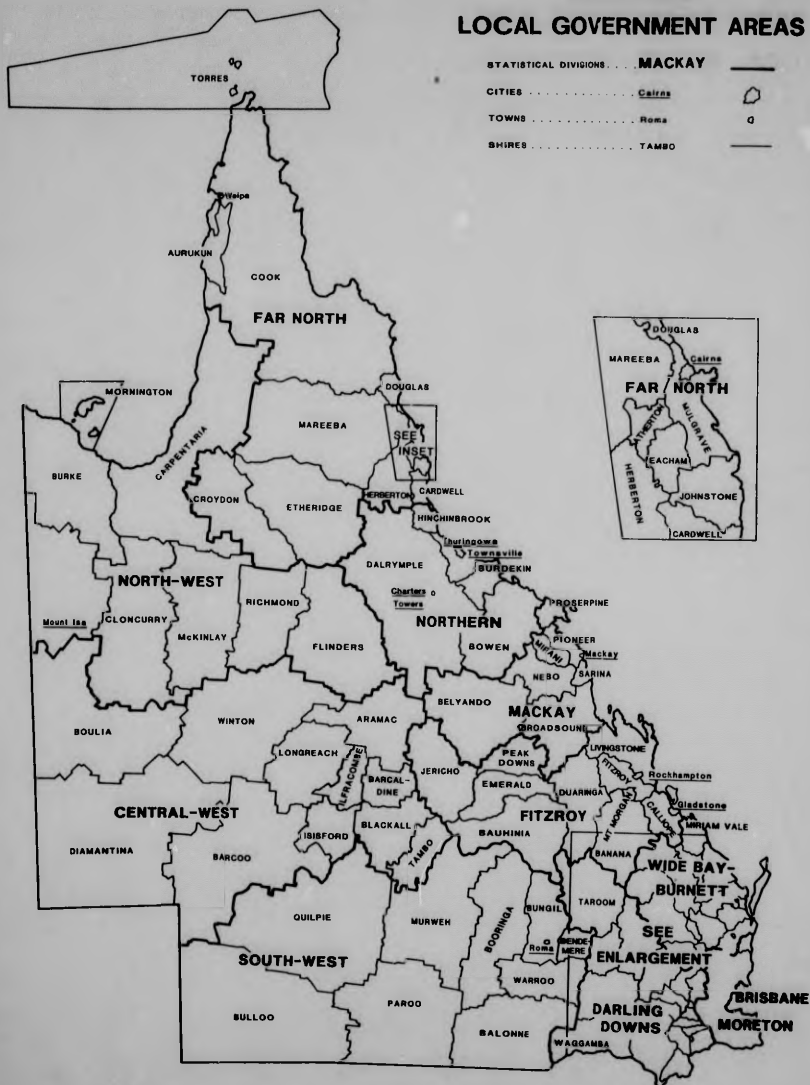
